## [REFUND POLICIES]

### **Refund Policy for General Recreation Instructional Classes**

Any participant may receive a refund of their registration fee minus a \$10.00 service charge if the refund is requested more than seven calendar days prior to the first scheduled class. An account credit may also be applied to a future program/activity if requested within seven calendar days of the first scheduled class.

### **Refund Policy for Facility Reservation Cancellations**

Any person may receive a refund for a facility reservation minus a \$10.00 service charge if the cancellation is requested more than seven calendar days prior to the actual reservation date. Refunds for reservations within seven calendar days of the reservation date will NOT be granted, but a credit may be applied to another date that must be used during the same calendar year and is based on availability.
