# INSIDE THE BRAIN OF A GOLF PRO

RE-INTRODUCING OUR GOLF PROFESSIONAL STAFF  
AND WHAT MAKES THEM TICK

They are the smiling faces in the Golf Shop, the "can-do" guys, and always ready to give a pointer on your golf game! They are our very own Horseshoe Bend CC Golf Professional Staff. Each day, they arrive with a great attitude and an eagerness to share their knowledge on the course, equipment, and approaches to the game. But how much do we really know? I caught up with each of them to ask four specific questions and find out a little more (and grab some tips for you too!).

**Name:** Alan Pickell

**Title:** Head Golf Professional

**Favorite Golf Course:** Isleworth Country Club; Orlando, FL

**Favorite Hole at HBCC:** Hole #18

**Everyone has an origin story. How did you get started with golf?**

A: I was very fortunate to be introduced to golf at a very young age. My father gave me my first club when I was two years old, and I never stopped!

**Golf is definitely a game of skill! What do you consider to be the most difficult shot to hit?**

A: I would have to say a 230 yard shot over water is the most difficult shot to handle.

**What instructions do you find yourself repeating the most during lessons?**

A: I find that most golfers have a tendency to flip their hands at impact. Most players will have the majority of their weight on their rear foot at impact and try to help the golf ball into the air. This is not only a mistake on the full swing, but especially on shorter shots.

**Horseshoe Bend CC has its own unique set of play challenges. What is your best tip for playing HBCC's course?**

A: Do not get above the hole on our greens. If you have a downhill putt in the summer time, good luck stopping the ball!



## THE BRAIN OF A GOLF PRO

**Name:** Kris Panachida

**Title:** Assistant Golf Professional

**Favorite Golf Course:** Athens Country Club, Athens GA

**Favorite Hole at HBCC:** Hole #11

KP: I started to play with my dad when I was two or three and never stopped playing.

KP: Long bunker shots are the hardest for me.

KP: Most common mistakes I see are usually at address, but the most common swing flaw is allowing the club head to get too far to the inside on the takeaway. This sets the path to the inside which will result in an over the top move to compensate for the early mistake.

KP: My tip for playing HBCC - Hit it in the fairway!



**Name:** Kyle Rice

**Title:** Second Assistant Golf Professional

**Favorite Golf Course:** Peachtree Golf Club; Atlanta, GA

**Favorite Hole at HBCC:** Hole #9 (best view)

KR: I started playing golf when I was 20. I was recovering from a broken leg and was looking to do something less physically demanding. I had an old set of clubs in the garage, and the rest is history!

KR: My most difficult shots are 15-25 yard bunker shots.

KR: I would say the most common flaw golfers have trouble with is alignment. A golfer can think they are aiming at one spot, but would actually be aiming at a completely different area. It is hard to work on a golf swing when you don't have a good understanding of where you are aiming. Once you have a good understanding of alignment, it can make life a lot easier.

KR: Don't bite off more than you can chew. HBCC can be a very straight forward course, if you let it. However, you can also get into quite a bit of trouble around the greens, and especially in the rough.

- The HBCC Mustang Swim Team is a club team in a recreational league. Swim Practices are held in order to help swimmers improve their strokes and learn new strokes. Swim team practice is not a time to teach basic swim lessons. The ratio of coaches to swimmers is too great to provide a one-on-one lesson experience. While we want to encourage younger children to swim and help them perfect their strokes, parents should consider some pre-season lessons to help get children ready for the season in order to have a safe and fun summer.

All HBCC Mustang swimmers must also register with the Atlanta Swim Association. The charge for the ASA league fee is \$24 per swimmer. ASA late fees will be in effect after April 15; the cost will be \$34 per swimmer after this date. The ASA fee will be charged to your member account at the same time as the other Swim Team fees.


