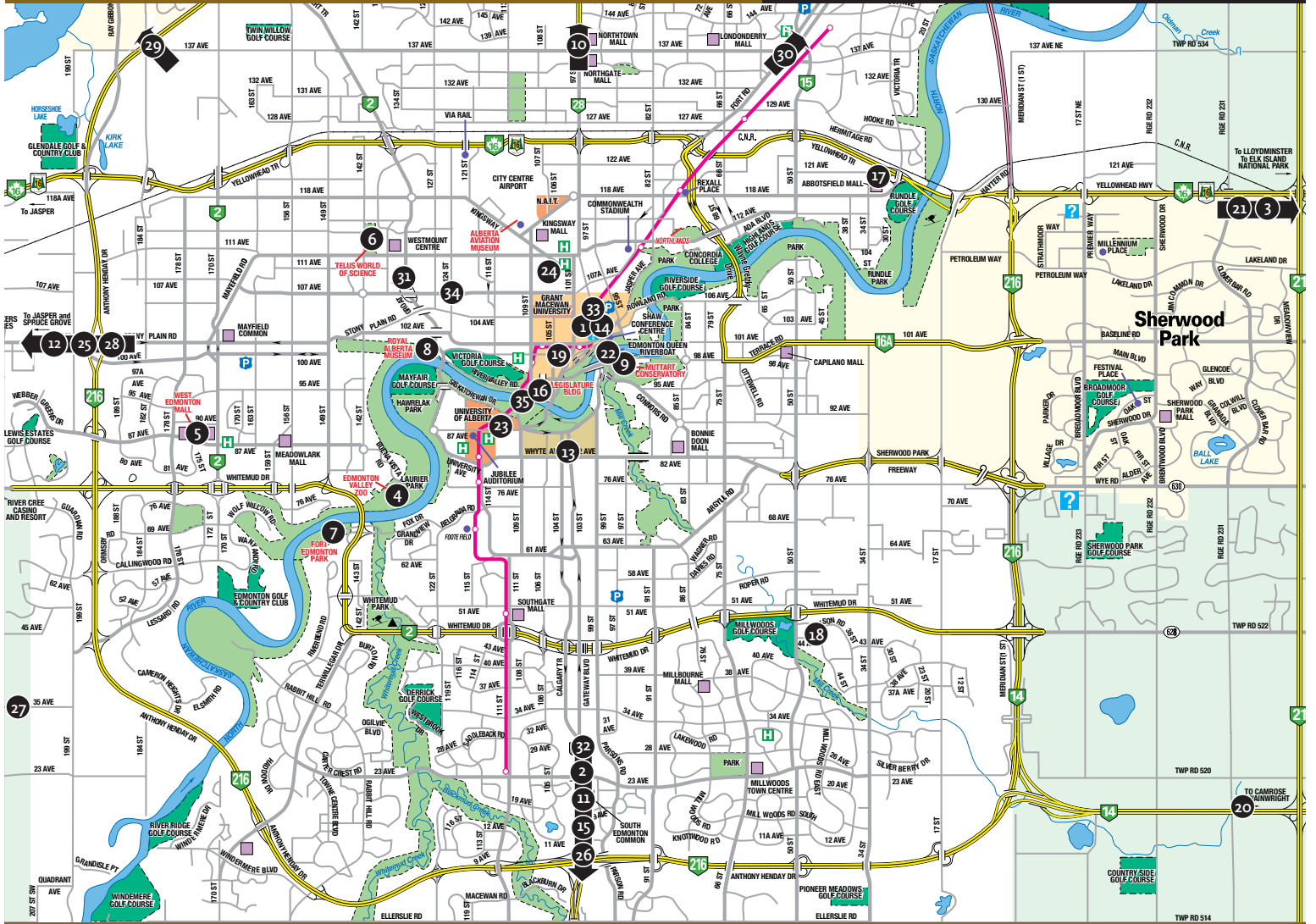

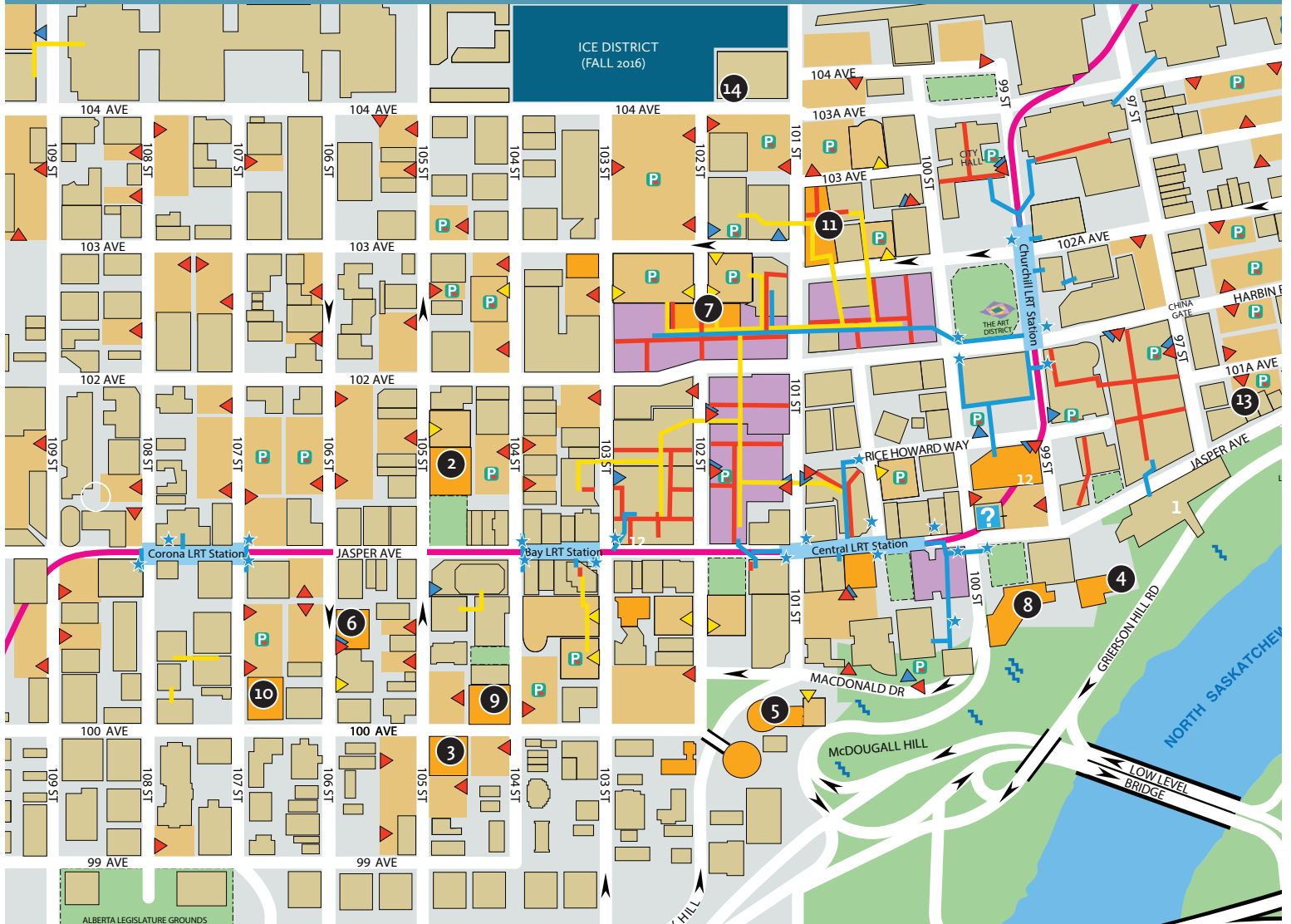

Downtown Hotel Map

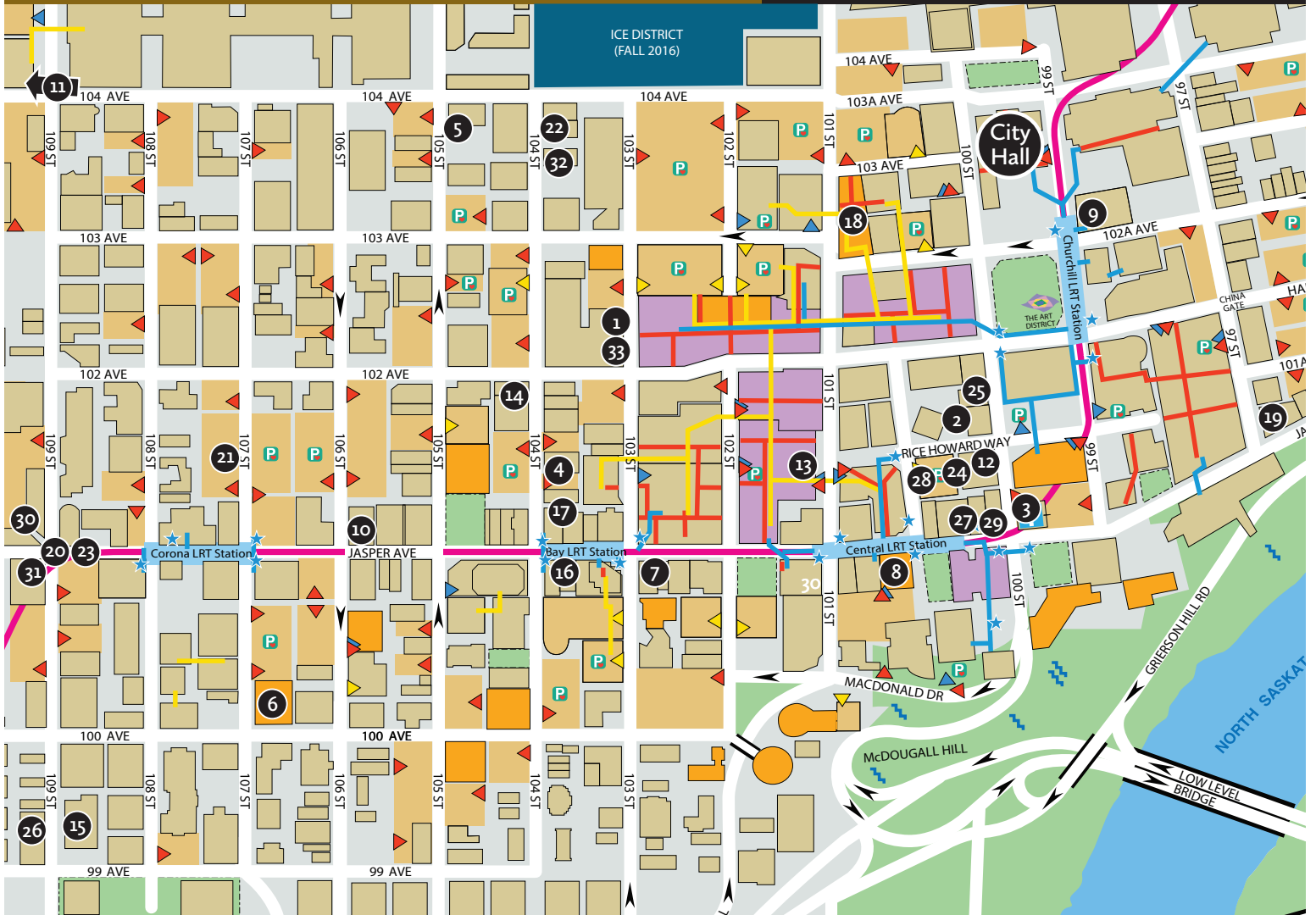
