### [REFUND POLICIES]

#### **Refund Policy for General Recreation Instructional Classes**

#### **Refund Policy for Facility Reservation Cancellations**

Any person may receive a refund for a facility reservation minus a \$10.00 service charge if the cancellation is requested more than seven calendar days prior to the actual reservation date. Refunds for reservations within seven calendar days of the reservation date will NOT be granted, but a credit may be applied to another date that must be used during the same calendar year and is based on availability.
