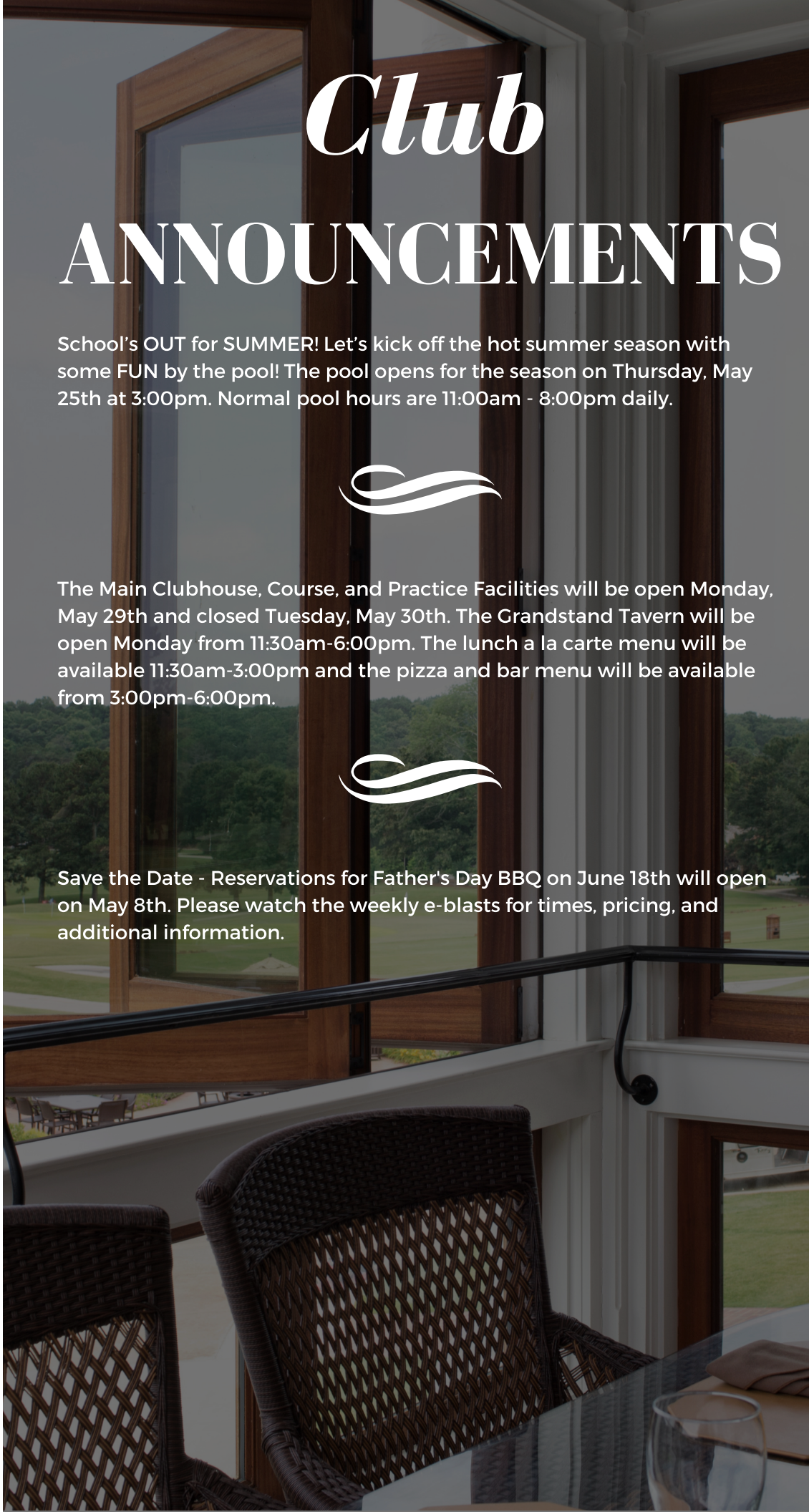

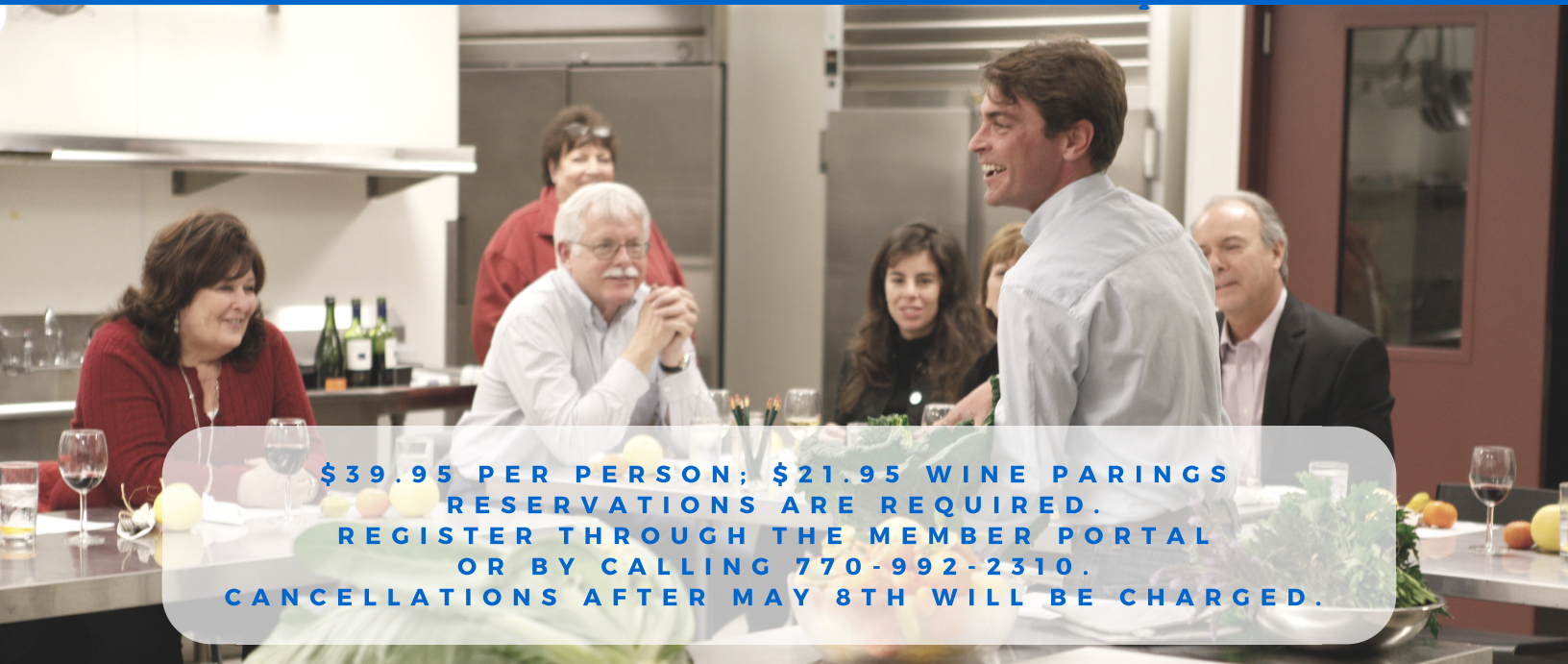

A LITTLE BIRDIE TOLD ME...

GAP MAINTENANCE BEGINS MAY 2ND

As we have in years past, we will use a gap in tee times on Tuesdays and Fridays from 11:10 to 12:10 to perform maintenance on the golf course. The gap begins the first week of May and runs until the end of September. Starting Tuesday, May 2nd, the gap will resume. Please keep this in mind when requesting tee times for the next few months.

On gap maintenance days, the golf course maintenance staff spends the morning hours preparing the course ahead of play, completing duties such as mowing and rolling greens, raking bunkers, changing cups, and moving tee markers. The gap is then used for our primary mowing activities such as tees, approaches, collars, and fairways. The gap also allows our staff to mow the grass when dry, which greatly reduces the amount of clippings that need to be blown, again increasing efficiency and providing a higher level of course conditioning.

One key to the gap's success is the pace of play of the groups playing both before and after the gap. If a group ahead of the gap plays slower than a four hour pace, the course maintenance staff runs the risk of not completing the tasks being performed that day. Behind the gap, if a group plays faster than a four hour pace, the gap will close, resulting in reduced efficiency for the course maintenance staff and decreased golfer satisfaction. We ask that you please keep this in mind if playing before or after the gap, so this method can continue to be a successful strategy for the maintenance of the course.

DRIVING RANGE OPERATING HOURS BEGINNING MAY 5TH

Much as we use the gap during the growing season to provide enhanced conditioning on the course, we also allow for a few extra hours of maintenance work at the Driving Range on Friday mornings. Starting Friday, May 5th, and on all Fridays until October 27, the Range will not be available until 9:00am. This time allows the course maintenance staff a second opportunity each week to mow the tees and other closely mown areas so they more consistently match course conditions. Much as we use the gap during the growing season to provide enhanced conditioning on the course, we also allow for a few extra hours of maintenance work at the Driving Range on Friday mornings. HBCC TENNIS NEWS

WORKING THE BACKHAND

Often, players tend to lack confidence in their backhand which really limits them with what they are able to do on the court. Take a look through these tips to improve your backhand and have more fun competing on court!

The most important stage in any stroke is the preparation, and this is no different with the backhand.

#1 - PREPARE THE RACQUET HEAD

This is the most important step and needs to be done before anything else. As you can see in the picture, the racquet head is up and is prepared by turning the hips and shoulders. Players often think of "taking the racquet back." This can confuse players as it is most natural to take the racquet back without turning the body. If you are having trouble generating pace or control on the backhand, think about turning the hips and shoulders instead of taking the racquet back.

#2 - MOVE TO THE BALL

This may sound obvious, however there is a correct way to move to the ball. We hear we need to side step across to the ball, however to enable us to prepare the racquet head and turn the hips and shoulders, we must "turn" and "run" to the ball. In sidestepping, the body won't be turned, resulting in a weak backhand that will often fall short. As you can see in the photo sequence, Djokovic turns and runs before hitting the ball.

#3 - DROP THE RACQUET HEAD AND ACCELERATE THROUGH CONTACT

Now that we have prepared and moved into position, it is time to hit the ball. To generate pace and also help us control the ball, we need to "drop the racquet head" under the ball and accelerate from underneath. The fastest part of our swing should be on contact.



#4 - FINISH/FOLLOW THROUGH

The control for our stroke comes from the follow through. The ball will tend to "fly" when we stop the racquet head on contact or shortly after contact. To improve your control, try to allow the racquet head to follow through and continue in its path towards the target.

Try to incorporate some of these tips on your backhand next time you step on court and turn that weakness into something your opponents will become scared of!
