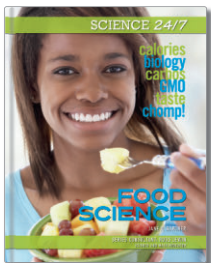
Uncle Gus said, “This tire is designed to have less friction with the track.”

The ranking system, compiled by researchers at the University of Melbourne's Institute of Applied Economic and Social Research, ranked each nation based on such things as government and private sector investment in higher education and the amount and type of research each university conducted.

Others explore the Great Barrier Reef, a crown jewel of Australia's tourism industry.

With a literacy rate of 99 percent, Australia's education system is strong. Students, like those in many other countries, must stay in school for twelve years before graduating to a university. Every classroom, from primary school to high school, includes students of the same age. Those who have trouble learning are put into special classes to give them the help they need. Most students start their schooling at the age of five. Those who are precocious attend "Child Care" centers or participate in "Family Day Care," a government-approved form of child care in which children go to the homes of educators. The education works closely with regulators who monitor the progress of the students.

The last two years of high school are considered extremely important for those wishing to attend a university or college. During those years, students are evaluated and ranked as they take their classes toward their chosen professions. For example, those who want to study engineering at a university will take classes in physics and high-level mathematics, instead of history or biology.

In addition to public schools, Australia has a number of schools run by various religious denominations, most notably the Roman Catholic Church. Still, as in other nations, the government has responsibility over these and other private schools. In Australia, state and territorial governments have the responsibility to oversee and fund education. Each is also responsible for the education of Aboriginal students.

In the past, Aboriginal students were treated as second-class citizens. In the early 1800s, Aboriginal children were taught to be laborers and servants to white colonial families. Some students were taken from their parents and brought to boarding schools.

During the twentieth century, boarding schools were closed.

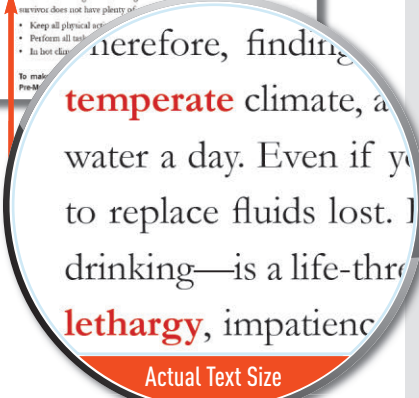
Of all the elements of survival, water is the most important. Without water, there is no life. Therefore all soldiers must know where to find, and how to prepare, water if they are to live in the wild for any length of time. No matter where you are, there are also many types of plant and animal foods available. Soldiers must learn where to find them, how to recognize them, how to collect or trap them, and be able to tell what is poisonous and dangerous.

In a survival situation, a person may be able to live without food for weeks in certain conditions. Without water, however, he or she will die within days. Therefore, finding water is the number-one priority for all survivors. In a temperate climate, a person needs to drink at least a half gallon (2.5 liters) of water a day. Even if you are doing very little physical activity, you need water to replace fluids lost. Dehydration—when you lose more water than you are drinking—is a life-threatening condition. The symptoms are a loss of appetite, lethargy, impatience, dizziness, nausea, slurred speech, and a failure to think straight. The treatment is straightforward: replace lost fluids by drinking water. Because sweating and breathing too hard can cause dehydration, if the survivor does not have plenty of water, he or she should wear a hat and use a bandana to keep the head cool.

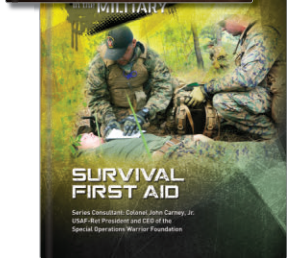
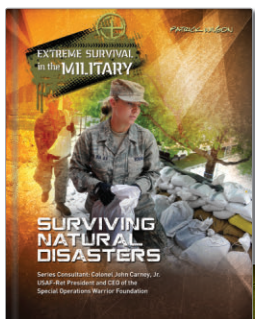
