The next two fastest final quarters were 24¾ each (Gallant Fox in 1930 and Count Fleet, who won the Belmont by 25 lengths, in 1943). Secretariat's legendary 31-length win in the 1973 Belmont recorded the fourth fastest final quarter, 25 flat.
