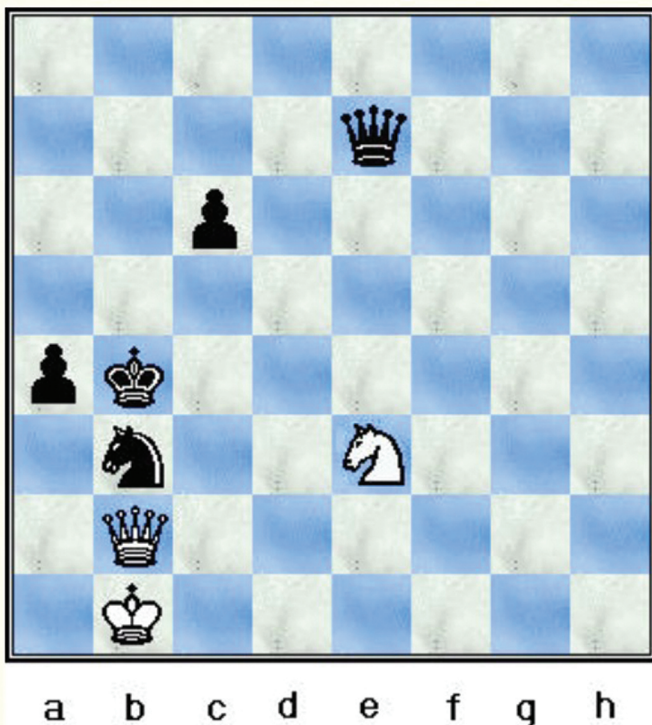

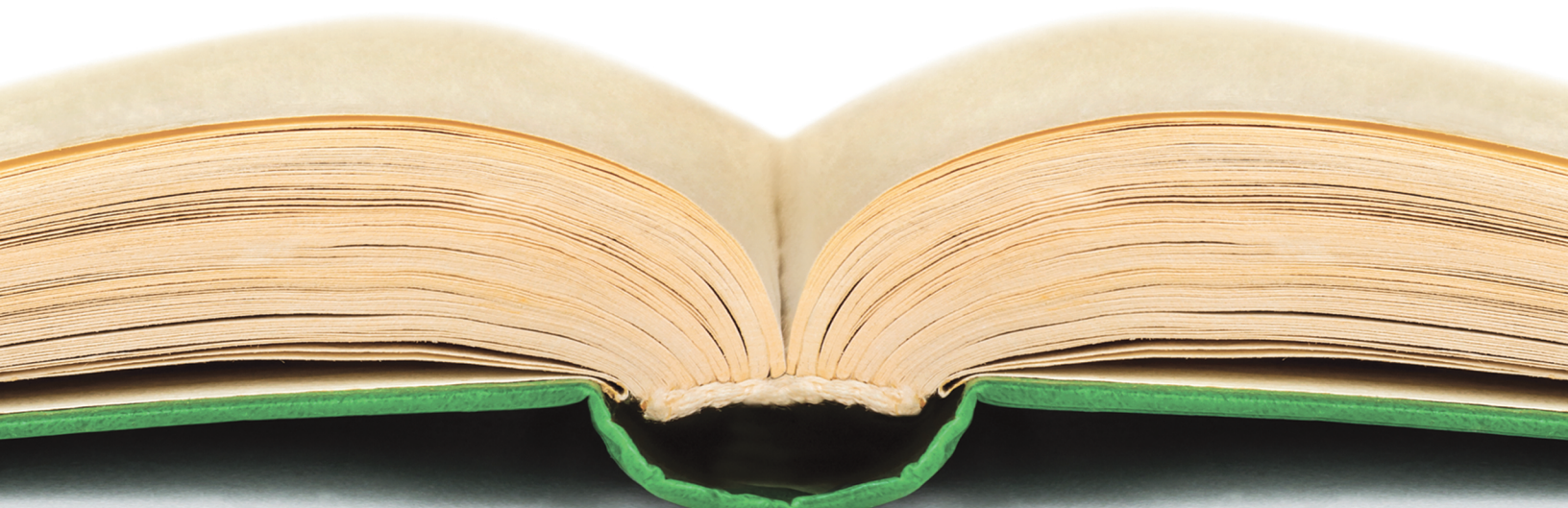

Our Volunteer Match Program is entering its third season at Frenchman's Creek. We've enjoyed our successful programs and now look forward to the challenge of sustaining our growth plus innovating new programs.

Thursday, November 10th at 10:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. - Volunteer Match Showcase

Last year was our first Showcase. Based, on its success, we are repeating it again this coming season and expect 30 agencies.

Friday, December 23rd at 11:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. - Kids Volunteer for the Red Cross

Last year we assembled 250 kits in record time; so, this year the goal is 500. Junior and senior high school students are also welcome and will be able to earn social-service credits.

HIGHLIGHTS OF LAST SEASON:

Led by Stuart Halpert last season we established an excellent relationship with the Palm Beach Gardens High School (PBGHS) in which about twenty of our members helped mentor students with their interview and presentation skills. At the other end of the educational spectrum, we will be welcoming volunteers at PBGHS who are able to work with children with "special needs" under the guidance of an exceptionally gifted teacher.

At the Ernie Els Center of Excellence in Jupiter for children with autism, our Frenchman's Creek members volunteered in the "Cut-Ups" program on Wednesday mornings preparing materials for teachers. And wouldn't you know, a grandmother of a child in the school that "cuts-up" with us is good friends with one of our Frenchman's residents.

We ended last season with a very successful "Clean Your Closets" donation program, which we hope to repeat again next April. (We are also considering a "Clean Your Cupboards" program for food donations as members leave for the season.)

Individual residents have volunteered at Jupiter Hospital, Take Stock in Children, the Edna Runner Early Learning after-school program, Morse Life and ARC programs at the Gardens Mall.

Golf Operations Update

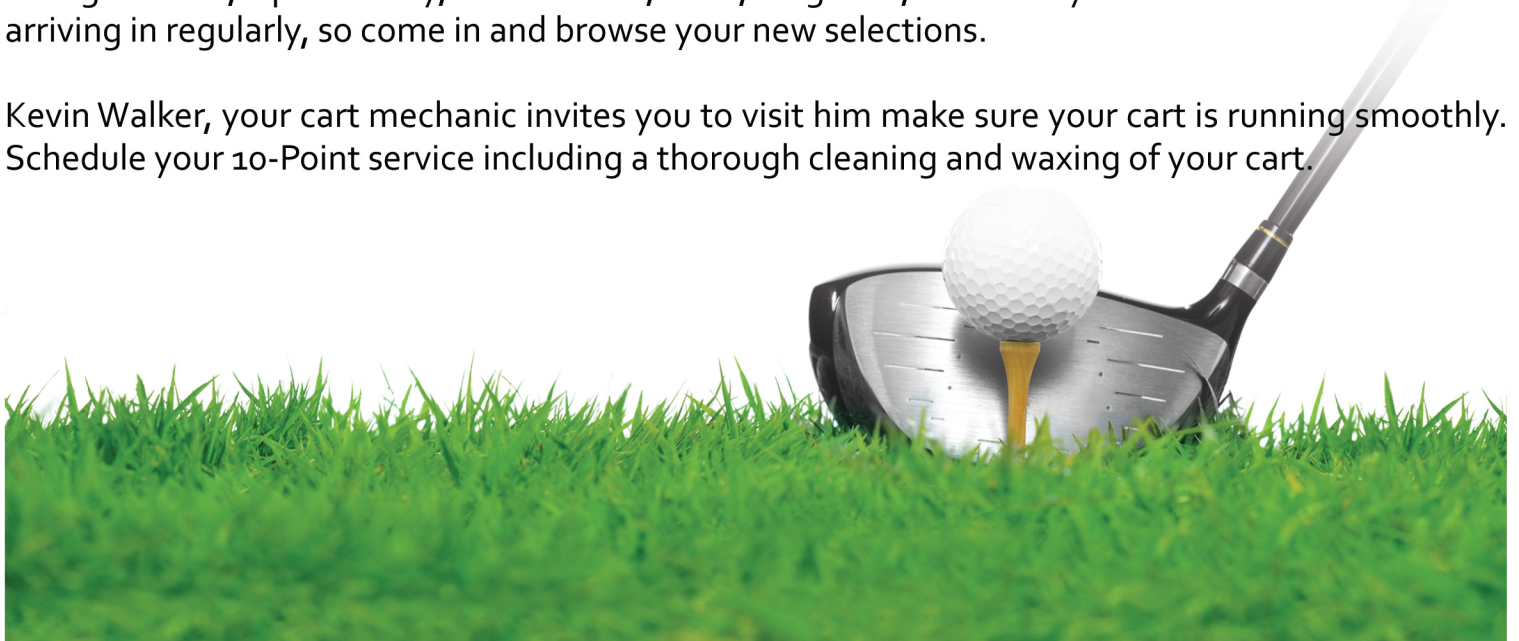

Practice Facility

The practice facility is available every day for our members and their guests for warm-up prior to your round of golf, for a golf lesson with one of your instructional staff members or for working on your game and refining your swing. Please Note: Children under the age of sixteen (16) must be accompanied by an adult and are required to utilize the North End (Back End) of the practice facility located by the sales center. All children should be dressed in golf attire at all times when using any part of the practice facility including the putting green.

Dress Code & Golf Course Etiquette

As a friendly reminder, members and their guests are required to adhere to the standards set at Frenchman's Creek Beach & Country. We all must follow the proper dress code policy on the golf courses as well as all of the practice facilities. Men are required to wear a collared shirt at all times. No denim, workout attire, tank tops or short shorts are acceptable attire for these areas. All members and guests should follow the proper golf course rules of etiquette. We ask that you adhere to the go degree rule while driving your cart, please fill in all your divots with sand, rake all bunkers, fix all ball marks on the green and maintain a four (4) hour pace of play. 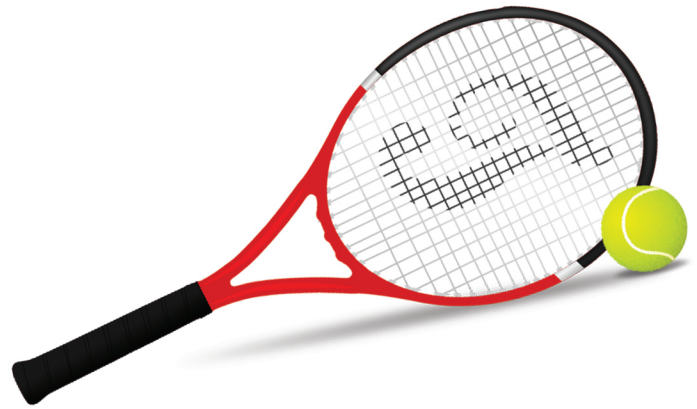

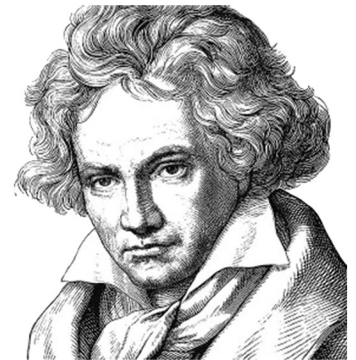
