History

From the Blackwater Valley to the Hunter Valley

The famous Blackwater Valley in Co. Cork, Ireland is where the Coolmore stallion tradition began in the 1850s with a man called Thomas Magnier. He started offering local breeders a stallion called Edlington, whose services cost the not inconsiderable sum of £3-0s-0d.

Thomas's grandson, Michael, stood a horse called Cottage, who sired Cottage Rake. Trained by the present John Magnier's father-in-law, the legendary Vincent O'Brien, Cottage Rake won the Cheltenham Gold Cup 3 years on the trot, a feat which put him into a small handful of highly exalted company.

Numerous champion jumping sires followed over the decades, including the remarkable Deep Run. He won 14 sire championships, an amazing feat for a National Hunt sire and his progeny landed all the major races at the Cheltenham Festival.

Coolmore has shuttled stallions to Australia, including the champion sire Last Tycoon, since the late 1970s. In 1996, Coolmore Australia was founded in the Hunter Valley and by 2005 the phenomenal Danehill had claimed his 9th Australian champion sire title.

Fastnet Rock and Encosta de Lago have both topped the sires' table on more than one occasion in recent years.

What began with Thomas Magnier in the Blackwater Valley, and which is still carried on today by his great-great grandson Tom in the Hunter Valley, is a tradition of standing top quality stallions.

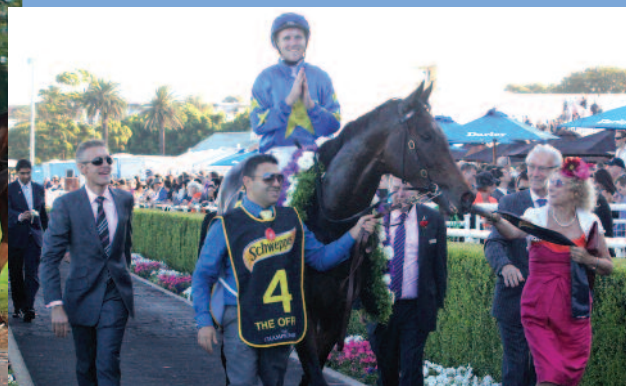

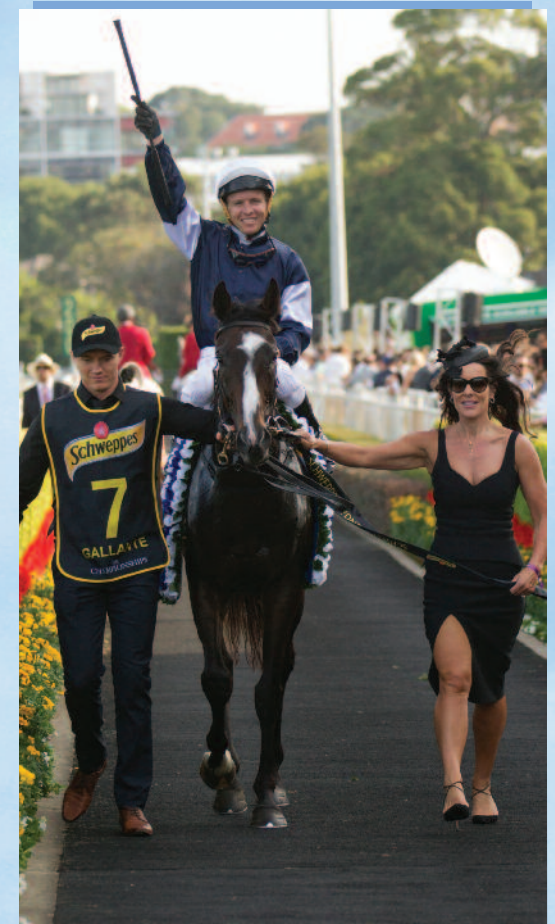

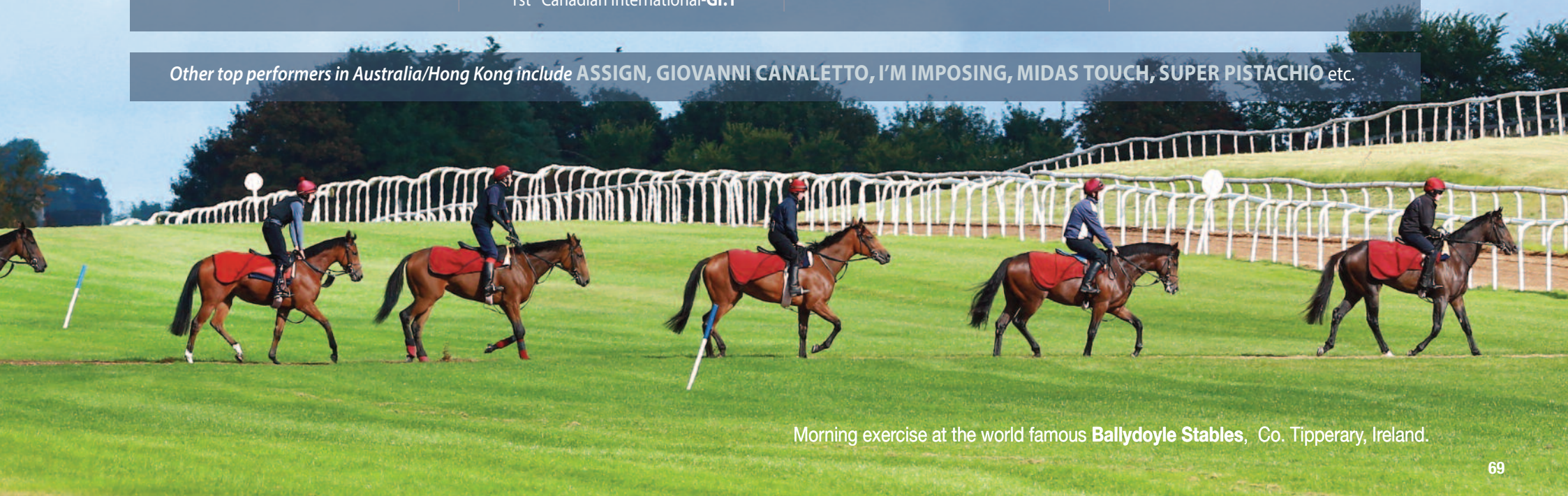

Coolmore Stud is acknowledged to be the world's pre-eminent thoroughbred racehorse breeding operation. It is situated in the heart of the Golden Vale on some of Ireland's finest limestone land.

John Magnier in conjunction with his father in law, the outstanding trainer Vincent O'Brien, and Robert Sangster purchased the then 350 acre farm from Battle of Britain flying ace Tim Vigors with the objective of creating a world-class stallion operation.

One of the first stallions to stand at Coolmore was **Be My Guest** who became champion sire in 1982. **Caerleon** then led the table in 1988 and again in 1991.

Sadler's Wells took his first sire's title in 1990 before becoming Europe's greatest ever sire. In 2004 he was champion sire for the 14th time, smashing **Highflyer's** record which was set way back in 1798. **Danehill**, the only multiple champion sire in Europe and Australia, then took up the baton with 3 titles from 2005 to 2007.

Galileo (sire of **Adelaide**) is now the world's best stallion and his reign since 2008 was broken only once, by his stud companion **Danehill Dancer** (sire of **Choisir**) in 2009.

Other exceptional sires to have stood at Coolmore include **Fairy King** (sire of **Encosta de Lago**), **Alzao**, **Night Shift**, **Royal Academy** (broodmare sire of **Fastnet Rock**), **Montjeu** and **High Chaparral** (sire of **So You Think**), while **Zoffany** was the first crop sire sensation in Europe in 2015.

Ashford Stud is located in the heart of Kentucky's famous Bluegrass. The initial tract of land that Ashford consisted of was originally owned by Col. Edmund H. Taylor Jr. who founded the Old Taylor Distilleries in nearby Frankfort. It was developed around 1912 and operated as a cattle farm up until the late 1970s. At that time, Dr. Bill Lockridge began to transform the farm into a state of the art stud, fit for the finest stallions in the world.

After three years of careful planning and construction, Ashford opened its doors for the 1982 breeding season. The stallion roster was headlined by Vincent O'Brien's champion 2yo **Storm Bird**.

When Ashford became part of Coolmore in the mid-1980s, **Storm Bird**, along with other top sires like **El Gran Senor** and **Woodman**, helped establish Coolmore's reputation on an international level.

In 2001 **Thunder Gulch** became the first champion sire to stand at Ashford. Not to be outdone, **Honour And Glory** (2000), **Hennessy** (2001), **Tale of the Cat** (2003), **Giant's Causeway** (2005 and 2014) and **Uncle Mo** (2015), all earned champion juvenile sire honours to go with those won by **Woodman** in 1990 and 1994.

Giant's Causeway landed three general sire titles (2009, 2010 and 2012); a feat only achieved by such luminaries as **Bull Lea**, **Nasrullah**, **Bold Ruler** and **Danzig** since 1941.

The current superstar is **American Pharoah**. A champion at 2 and 3 years, he became the first Triple Crown winner for 37 years before finishing his racing career with a record-breaking Breeders' Cup Classic victory.
