

CHESS CLUB

Find the greatest chess move of all times. This is a situation from the final game of the 1998 Linares Chess Tournament. Black is to move and Alexei Shirov makes what is believed to be the greatest chess move of all times. This is definitely a high difficulty situation and by analyzing it you will gain great insides of end game strategies. Few things to consider: 1 always plan to promote to queen,2 two fronts are better than one front of attack, 3 pawns in chain are stronger than individual set ups,4 sacrifice smart. Try to find the best move for black.

Last month's solution:

The best move for white would be Queen from D6 to H6. This is the only option where white checkmates black instantly. The rest of the options appear to take two-three moves. In Chess we aim to achieve check-mate situations, rather than just check.


THE BRICKMAN GROUP


Pickleball was created with one thing in mind: FUN. It was designed to be easy to learn and play whether you are five, eighty-five or something in between.


