Something important to think about !!!

There happens to be a topic we do not think about but is very important. It is two fold and involves security and our medical history. Director of Security, Mark Hall, just sent an e-mail restating the procedure of an emergency call. In keeping with this, it is important that security has an up to date record of your medical history and the medicines you are taking. This is of course most confidential, but necessary if there is an emergency.

Next item is it is important to have a person designated as an emergency contact-probably a family member and not necessarily one in town. This brings us to another item, especially to those members who are single and do not have a relative nearby. Select a member of Frenchman's to be notified in case of an emergency and register that name with security.

This is something one does not think about until it is too late so please give it some thought.
