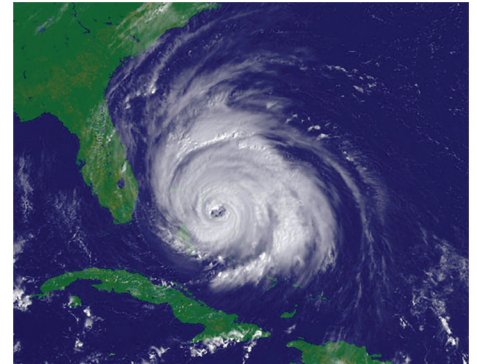
House Watch Program

Dear Frenchman's Creek Members,

As the season comes to a close, I would once again like to thank the entire membership for their warm welcome and support during my transition back to what I consider home.

Since returning, I have taken the past 4 months to observe the entire golf operation and overall play patterns here at Frenchman's Creek. The two things that have been the most notable to me is where golf carts are being driven by both those with medical flags and without medical flags and the other is the dress attire that is being worn on the practice facility and putting green. The club has clearly stated policies related on both, but as a reminder they are recapped below.

Use of Golf Cart: Golf carts must be operated in strict accordance with the posted instructions for the day. Our typical cart traffic rule is the scatter policy. The scatter rule means that carts can be driven on fairways and roughs, but when the cart is equal to the colored balls (Red & Yellow) in front of the green, the cart must be returned to the nearest cart path, which is indicated by the yellow ball. Members with medial flags are permitted to approach greens and tees, no nearer than fifteen (15) feet and no nearer than ten (10) feet from a bunker and the water's edge.

(Golf Carts are not permitted on the North range tee at any time and on cart path only days "COP" all carts must remain on paths at all times (including those with disability flags).

Dress Attire: Proper attire is required on the golf course and practice facility at all times. Clothing that are not permitted on the golf course or practice facility for both men and women would be tank tops, jeans, tennis / short-shorts, or workout clothing.

Thoro-Guard Lightning Prediction System: As we enter the summer season we also begin the period of thunderstorms and lightening. The Thoro-Guard Lightning prediction system has been tested and is ready. One blast long blast of the horn means there is imminent lightening danger. Play is suspended and all golfers should immediately seek the nearest shelter. Two short blast of the horn indicates, the threatening weather has dissipated and it is safe to resume play. Everyone should remember that the system is a prediction system and is not full proof and one should always access the threat risk and should use their best common judgment.

We hope that you have had an enjoyable season and we promise to make next season even better.

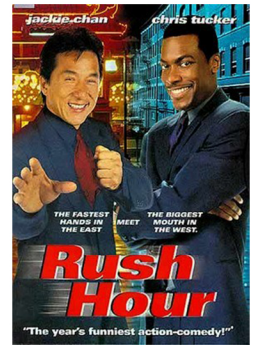
