Open the Live Portrait App, hover your phone over the photograph (any print medium will do), and the video will play, making your image appear to come to life.

Note: The front cover image of players and cheerleaders on ladders at night, and the Ironman picture of athletes in weight room have videos that will play when using the Live Portrait app.


Assistant Coach Defensive Line


Princess Senoia

Senoya He-ne-ha was the wife of Captain William McIntosh. Their son, Chief William McIntosh was both a General in the army and a chief in his band of Creek Indians. Senoya was a member of the prestigious Wind Clan of the Creek Indians. She was also known as, "Princess Senoya."

Senoya was a member of the important Wind Clan. The Muskogee's (the true name of the Creek Indian Nation) believed that their clans, like all their important social institutions originated in the ancient past. According to legend, it was believed that their early knowledge of their environment was "buried and covered as it were in a dense fog impenetrable to their powers of vision. Being unable to see (understand) they were dependent on their other senses to obtain subsistence." In their quest for survival, the people became separated. "After a great while there arose a wind from the east that gradually drove the fog from the land. The group of people who first saw clearly was given the name of the Wind Clan." As the fog continued to recede other groups of people came to light; and, as each looked about, it adopted the symbol of the clan by which it would thereafter be known, the first live animal which had emerged from the fog along with it. In this manner, the leading four clans (Hathagalgi) were established and were recognized as leaders in the establishment and maintenance of peace in the nation.

Since the clan title passed through the mother's side of the family, McIntosh inherited the leadership role which was so dominant in establishing present-day Coweta Count. Furthermore, the eastern part of a plot of land took on the greatest significance. Within Creek legend, East Coweta would be the most hallowed ground within the county.

Here under the Friday night lights at East Coweta High School, you will find our representation of "Princess Senoia" as she rides on her horse and throws her spear before the first kick off of every home game. Lindsey Mons, Senior, is currently serving as Princess Senoia. The first horseback riding Princess Senoia at ECHS began in 1988, by Kelly Snyder. Some other alumni who also had the honor of serving as our Princess Senoia were Rachel Boren and Lauren Cheek.
