In Brisbane Waters National Park, Girrakool, Warrah Reserve and Bouddi National Parks, along the coastal walks and on the Somersby Plateau, many of these can be seen flowering from early July.



ask the expert

I've been a sleep deprived shift worker for many years. When I get ■ home I have trouble winding down, so spend hours staring into a computer screen until I finally nod off from total exhaustion. I've finally now come to understand I was in denial thinking I could just soldier on and stay healthy on 3-5 hours sleep and a diet including heaps of junk food. I'm not even 40 and a recent check-up revealed that my blood pressure & sugar levels are elevated. To add insult to injury I also have a fatty liver! And I thought this stuff only happened to substance abusers & alcoholics (FYI I don't drink). I realise medications can control but not actually fix my problems. I prefer not to go there if possible anyway and until now have avoided taking any prescription drugs. Have I done irreversible damage or can anything natural help in my situation?

Sleep deprivation is the curse of the busy hi-tech age and now sadly epidemic. Yours is the classic case of the diligent worker snared in the unsustainable lifestyle cycle. Everybody wants more energy & stamina, yet few understand that a vibrant life only emanates from the balance that brings about recovery in the truly natural scheme of living.

A recent study demonstrated the negative implications of constantly gazing into electronic blue screens via laptops, mobiles etc. even in the very young i.e. decreased concentration ...and what a surprise – sleep deprivation. Without restful & adequate quality sleep (7-8 hours) our bodies rapidly lose ground in the fight against premature ageing. For some of us, it can be difficult to maintain a healthy smile, even without wearing metal braces. Our friends at The Ortho Practice Kincumber share their 7 tips for maintaining a healthy, clean smile during treatment.

- 1. Avoid sugary and sticky foods. It's no secret that foods high in sugar and acid can damage your teeth and increase plaque. You will often hear your orthodontist remind you to steer clear of nuts, apples and other hard foods to avoid damaging your braces. Sticking to a low sugar diet with soft and healthy foods is the first step in maintaining a healthy smile whilst you or your child has braces.
- 2. Brush regularly. We recommend brushing for three minutes, three times per day. However, with braces we also recommend you brush each time you eat to avoid a buildup of food and plaque around your teeth and gums. It may seem extreme, however it is very important during treatment as braces can often get in the way of giving your teeth a thorough clean.
- 3. Try disclosing tablets. Ask your orthodontist for these. They are chewable tablets which turn plaque deposits to pink to help you see where plaque has built up around your teeth. This makes it easier to concentrate on the parts of your mouth that need extra attention.
- 4. Healthy toothbrush, healthy smile. Normally we would advise changing your soft bristled toothbrush every three months. However, the bristles may wear down quicker with braces making your toothbrush less effective in cleaning your teeth and gums. We recommend changing your toothbrush every other month or more frequently if needed.
- 5. Don't forget to floss. This can be difficult with braces. However, where possible it is important to clean between your teeth to avoid cavities and gum disease. Often patients forget to floss as they believe it is impossible. We are here to tell you it is possible, a bit tricky but totally worth it.
- 6. Try rinsing. If you are at a restaurant or a friend's house and your toothbrush or floss are nowhere in sight - try rinsing you mouth with water. This will help rinse away any bits of food stuck in your braces. It will also help neutralise some of the sugar and acid in your mouth after a meal. Just don't forget to brush the moment you get home as this will not be enough to keep your smile clean.
- 7. Visit your dentist. Above all, please remember that it is important to visit your dentist twice a year for regular check-ups and a professional clean. Your dentist will work with your orthodontist to ensure that by the end of your treatment you will be left with not only a beautiful smile, but a healthy one.



Being unhappy isn't the same as being depressed. Depression is a term often used loosely to describe how we feel after a bad week at work or when we get dumped. But major depressive disorder — a type of depression — is much more complicated. There are specific symptoms and signs that determine whether it's depression or just a case of the Mondays.

Major depression is a mood disorder that affects the way you feel about life in general. Having a hopeless or helpless outlook on your life is the most commonly associated

symptom of depression. Other feelings may be worthlessness, self-hate, or inappropriate guilt. Common, reoccurring thoughts of depression are vocalized as, "It's all my fault," or "What's the point?"

Depression can take the pleasure or enjoyment out of the things you love. A loss of interest or withdrawal from activities that you once looked forward to — sports, hobbies, or going out with friends — is yet another telltale sign of major depression. Another symptom of major depression is a decreased sex drive and even impotence.

Part of the reason you might stop doing things you enjoy is because you feel very tired. Depression often comes with a lack of energy and an overwhelming feeling of lethargy, which can be the most debilitating symptoms of depression. This could lead to excessive sleeping or no sleep at all.

Depression is also linked to insomnia, as one might lead to the other and vice versa. They can also make each other worse. The lack of quality, restful sleep can also lead to anxiety.

The physical and mental toll of depression also contributes to anxiety and irritability. Depression also affects the sexes differently. Research shows that in addition to irritability men may display symptoms not typically associated with depression, like escapist or risky behaviour, substance abuse, or misplaced anger.

Weight and appetite can fluctuate differently for each person with major depression. Some will have an increased appetite and gain weight while others won't be hungry and lose weight. A distinguishing factor to determine if the dietary changes are related to depression is whether they are intentional or not. If they're not, it might be a clue that something larger is wrong.

One minute it's an outburst of anger. The next you're crying uncontrollably. Nothing outside of you prompted the change, but your emotions are up and down at a moment's notice. Depression can swing your moods around, keeping you away from the calm you so desperately want. In a similar way to another mood disorder, bipolar disorder, moods can fluctuate uncontrollably, which is one reason why the two are often confused

The scariest reality with depression is its connection with suicide. Suicides rarely come without showing symptoms first. Often people will talk about it or have a first attempt before succeeding in ending their life. If you or someone you know are suicidal, reach out and talk to someone who cares and can help you.... call 131 114 today or see your local doctor.

If you have had some of the previously mentioned symptoms for more than two weeks, you might be suffering from major depression disorder. Recognizing that you are depressed and finding the right information is pivotal to getting the right help. Depression affects millions of people, but there are varying treatments available, from lifestyle changes to medications. No matter the path of treatment you choose, asking for professional help is the first step to getting back to feeling like yourself again and finding peace and happiness.

t's a fact that nearly all men will lose some or all of their hair over time. There's a hereditary element, so if your father lost his hair by the age of forty, there's a good chance that you will too - but if your grandfather had a full head of hair at eighty, then you may also.

The main reason why most people lose their hair is male-pattern baldness - and women can develop it as well, despite the name. It usually follows the same pattern, a receding hairline, then hair thinning out on the crown of the head and at the temples. Many men find that their hair loss either slows down or stops completely as they get to retirement age.

Male-pattern baldness only affects the hair on your scalp. Alopecia, another cause of hair loss, can mean losing the hair everywhere on your body, though not everyone with alopecia is this seriously affected. If the hair on your head starts coming out in patches, see your GP it could be alopecia.

An underactive thyroid can also make your hair fall out, as can losing weight suddenly- another reason why it's best to try to reduce your weight gradually. Whatever the cause, losing your hair can really lower our self-esteem, whether you're male or female, and support groups can be useful for anyone who has problems with it. It can be particularly traumatic for women also, but there is help available, so do ask.

Male-pattern baldness got its name because it's related to the male hormone testosterone, but testosterone levels are usually normal in someone who's losing their hair in this way. What happens is that the hair follicles convert testosterone into dihydrotestosterone, which can cause them to shrink, and as they shrink each new hair is thinner than the one before until they become so short and fine that they don't appear above the surface of the skin.

There's some work being done which suggests that reducing the level of testosterone will help, and there are drugs which can block the conversion of testosterone, so talk to your GP if worried

about it. Drug treatments are only effective while you are using them though. Women who experience male-pattern baldness should always get themselves checked out, as it could be a sign of having raised testosterone levels due to polycystic ovary syndrome.

Alopecia can strike at any age, but most sufferers have their first run-in with it in their teens or early twenties as this condition can come and go. Some aspects of alopecia are still unexplained, for example we don't know why only some parts of the scalp are affected. About 20% of sufferers have a relative who has also had it at some point. It is believed to be an auto-immune disease, one in which the hair follicles are attacked by the body's immune system, because it somehow sees them as 'foreign'. This fall out, and the distinctive bald patches develop. If the immune reaction dies down, the follicles are capable of growing hair again, and in some cases the hair grows back in a year or so.

If you're anaemic, you may be deficient in iron, folate and vitamin B12, and that will affect your hair. If you think this might be the case perhaps you are feeling very tired and run-down without having a specific reason for being so - ask your GP for a blood test.

In some cases, low levels of zinc have been associated with hair loss. If you eat plenty of seafood, organ meats, eggs, milk and wholegrain products, this will build up your zinc intake. Also for folate, ensure you eat plenty of dark green leafy vegetables and legumes. B12 can be found in dairy products, fish, oysters, shellfish, liver and kidney and dark chocolate is a good source of iron, as are meat, eggs, whole grains and green vegetables.

There are a lot of possible causes of sudden hair loss. It could be a symptom of lupus or a thyroid condition, as well as anaemia and polycystic ovaries. Beware of expensive 'wonder cures' there are lot's out there. Your GP can prescribe medications if male-pattern baldness is causing you great distress.



The 5 biggest mistakes people make choosing **WINDOW COVERINGS**

hether you are renovating your existing home or moving into a brand new place, there are 5 fundamental mistakes you must not do when choosing your Window Coverings.

1. Buy cheap, buy twice. Don't get me wrong, there is always a time and a place to buy cheap. You might be moving soon; blowing up the place, maybe it's a room that is never used...or the little window in the garage? That makes sense!

But let's talk about your own home that you live in now. This is the place you want to feel comfortable and relaxed in. The wisest thing to do is spend money on quality window furnishings in the most lived, visible areas of your home. Usually the Lounge/Dining area and also the Master bedroom. Get what you really want in these areas. Remember most window furnishings will last up to 8 years. We've all heard stories of friends who claimed that got a 'bargain' only be stressed with shoddy work, tardy tradesman and poor quality goods.

2. Everything has to match. No it doesn't! When it comes to window furnishings, every room in the house does not have to be the same. But can if you like. Let me explain. Just like people have feature walls, people have feature window furnishings. People have themed coloured rooms, themed textures or casual versus formal areas. You need to make a decision on whether your blinds

will be a feature in the room, compliment an existing feature - say a lounge, or be a neutral backdrop to compliment a stunning view! Sometimes the blind is the feature, sometimes the room, the view or the furniture is the feature. All answers are correct!

3. Choose Style over Function. Sometimes, you have to choose function first, and then work out the style that suits you. Think about how often you use that sliding door? Are you in and out of it all day every day? Do you have a kitchen window that the neighbours can see straight in to? Then choose something practical.

Most window furnishings are fabric and as sturdy as they can be and there is only a certain amount of abuse they can take. Also remember things like 'block out fabric' for bedrooms to protect your sleep from early morning sunlight. 'block out blinds" are great for hot western facing windows that heat up the house. Remember, a block out blind darkens the room. On a hot day you may not want the house dark, so ask your window furnishing consultant for advice on giving you privacy and protection from the sun without a dark house.

4. There's nothing wrong with it. Outdated stained mouldy blinds need to go! Just because they still work, does not mean they are suitable for your windows. Everything has a lifespan. Think of it

this way. If you went to sell your home with blinds like that, what would the new buyer think? It screams out "neglect" and they start looking for faults in the home. You wouldn't sell a dirty car. Like a fresh coat of paint, new blinds add a fresh look instantly to a room for a minimal cost.

5. Remember the Environment. It is scary these days, but like many industries the blind industry has been hit by cheap imports from Asia. There is minimal testing for lead or formaldehyde in these fabrics before they are imported. It concerns me there may be all types of nasties seeping into your room on a hot day. Purchase your blinds from a reputable dealer, preferably one that has mainly Australian made products.

The insulation of your home can be really influenced with the right blinds, awnings or shutters. Considering a large percentage of the heat and cold enters your home via your windows, blinds are a great insulator. Anything you put on the inside or outside of your window will slow down the process and help keep your home better insulated. With the cost of energy these days, blinds and awnings are as good as any tool to save you money by keeping your home better insulated.

any people make New Year's resolutions – it makes sense because it connects us up to the idea of starting something afresh, giving ourselves another chance and settling down again into doing some of the hard work that will help us make the changes we want in our lives.

Guess what? New Year isn't the only time that you can do this. As we're starting to come into the warmer weather, most people start to feel a little more energetic and feel a lift in their mood. So take advantage of it! Spring is a great time to focus on making some changes that you might have been wanting to make. It's the perfect time to "take stock" or make an inventory of how you're going in some particular areas of your life – in particular: mood, sleep, exercise and eating.

I always encourage people to spend time writing down and keeping track of what they're actually doing rather than relying on what they think they are doing - so here's a way that will help you spring into Spring.

For the next week, keep a mood diary. There are plenty of them available online but here's a link to one produced by the Australian Psychological Society:

http://eqip.psychology.org.au/Assets/ Files/Prac%20Tool.Mood%20Diary%20 Worksheet.pdf

It's easy-to-use and will help you track your daily mood and hours of sleep. In addition to that, I encourage you to record the amount of daily activity that you do – of any sort. It doesn't matter whether it's walking, gym or something else. Finally - keep an accurate food diary for about a week so you get a sense of what your eating patterns are currently like.

At the end of this time, have a look at the notes you kept and decide what changes might be helpful for you. It may be useful for you to plan to go to sleep a little earlier, wake a little earlier, exercise more, cut down on alcohol, minimise the number of "food treats" that you have or perhaps something else that's particular to you.

As always, if you have any concerns about how you're feeling or functioning in your daily life, chat with your GP and ask about seeing a Psychologist.

I think Spring is a great time of year to start thinking about goals and dreams for the coming year and to start a little bit of the preparation work that will help you get there. **Good luck!**

Salmon & Spinach Cannelloni

Ingredients

600g salmon fillet, skin removed

10-12 cannelloni tubes 1 tbsp olive oil

1 brown onion, finely chopped

2 cloves garlic, crushed 120g spinach

150mL cooking cream 1 tbsp dill, finely chopped 1 tbsp tarragon, finely chopped

1 tbsp lemon zest

1 tbsp lemon juice

1/2 tsp nutmea

300mL creme fraiche

100g cheddar cheese,

grated

2 egg yolks

50g parmesan, roughly

grated

Place the salmon on a greased baking tray and roast in the oven at 100°C for 10 minutes. Remove from the oven and flake with your fingers.

Preheat oven to 180°C. Lightly spray with oil a medium-sized ovenproof dish.

Heat oil in a large frying pan over medium heat. Add onion and garlic and cook for 3 - 4 minutes or until softened. Add spinach and cook for a minute, or until just wilted. Season with salt and pepper. Stir through the cooking cream, nutmeg, dill, tarragon, lemon zest and juice. Divide the mixture in two. Combine half with the flaked salmon and reserve the rest.

Using a teaspoon, spoon the salmon and spinach mixture into 10 - 12 cannelloni tubes.

Combine the cheese, creme fraiche and egg yolk with the remaining spinach sauce. Pour half of the sauce into the baking tray and nestle the cannelloni side by side in the sauce. Spread the other half over the top of the cannelloni.

Sprinkle with parmesan, cover with foil and bake for 20 - 25 minutes. Remove the foil and finish under the grill for 1 - 2 minutes until golden brown. Serve with green salad and lemon wedges.






