





At the April 16th – Board Meeting the Board of Governors voted to amend the Hurricane Shutter Installation Policy. Hurricane Shutters can now be installed from May 1st on.

Frenchman's Creek, Inc. **Rules and Regulations** 

#### XIII. Hurricane Policy

H. Hurricane and storm shutters may be installed at the beginning of hurricane season but no earlier than May 1st and are required to be removed by November 30th, except in cases where a tropical storm warning is pending.

- ◆ Close all doors to the dog park after entering or exiting.
- ◆ If your dog becomes unruly or plays rough, please control it as not to disturb the other dogs.
- Any dogs showing signs of aggression should be removed from the premises.
- Owners are responsible for the behavior of their animals.





## Closing your Home for the Summer?



Here are a few tips to keep in mind before leaving for the summer

## <u>Summer Departure List:</u>

- \* Call the POA Office to schedule a meeting with your landscape supervisor to review any special landscape maintenance needs you may have while away this summer.
- \* Leave an emergency telephone number and the phone number of your house watch person with Security and the POA office.
- Leave a forwarding address with the post office.
- \* Discontinue newspaper service.
- \* Make sure all doors and windows are looked and the security alarm is set.
- \* Secure patio furniture and all moveable items in the garage.
- \* If the electricity is turned off to the refrigerator, prop the door open and turn the ice maker water valve off.
- \* Leave the air conditioning on to avoid mildew and corrosion.
- \* Turn off the water supply to the washer and disconnect washing machine hoses.
- \* Unplug the water supply to the washer and the circulating pump.
- \* Turn off water valve to all water faucets.
- \* Have your house treated regularly by a pest control provider.
- \* LEAVE ON THE POWER SWITCH TO YOUR OUTSIDE POST LIGHTS.

# KATHY'S HOUSE WATCH PROGRAM

## Weekly Inspection of your home

- Check to make sure your pool is being maintained.
- Check that appliances and A/C units are in working condition.
- Email pictures of your home bi-weekly.
- Accept home deliveries.
- Patio furniture take indoors for the summer, put out for the season (\$39 per man hour).
- Unlocks for packages and home deliveries.
- Arrange for pressure cleaning of your patio per your request (price to be quoted).
- Prepare your home for storms, store pots in the garage and arrange to have hurricane shutters installed or closed (\$39 per man hour)
- Flush toilets / check faucets.
- Checking doors and windows to be sure they are secure.
- Smoke / CO detector checks.
- Regular car start-up

# KEVIN'S SUMMER GOLF CART MAINTENANCE SERVICES

## Security

Are your evenings frequently interrupted by a scam call or a telemarketing company? There is a way to put a stop to it! The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) receives complaints daily from all over the nation in regard to unwanted to calls. Pursuant to its authority under the Telephone



Consumer Protection Act (TCPA), the FCC along with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) established a National **Do-Not-Call Registry**. This registry is nationwide and applies to all telemarketers (except certain non-profit organizations). Commercial telemarketers are not permitted to call you if your number is on this registry. As consumers with this service, you can eliminate the unwanted calls to your home and or mobile device. Here is how it works. You can register all of your numbers for free and these numbers will remain on the list until removed by you or if you discontinue your phone service. You will never need to re-register phone numbers. The Do-Not-Call Registry does not prevent all unwanted calls. The following are not covered:

- Calls from organizations with which you have established a business relationship
- Calls for which you have given prior written permission
- Calls which are not commercial or do not include unsolicited advertisements
- calls by or on behalf of tax-exempt non-profit organizations

Consumers may register their residential phone numbers as well as wireless numbers on the national Do-Not-Call Registry at no cost.
