New in the POA office is **Susie Carrasquillo** and **Sierra Parry**. They are there to assist you, always with a pleasant smile.

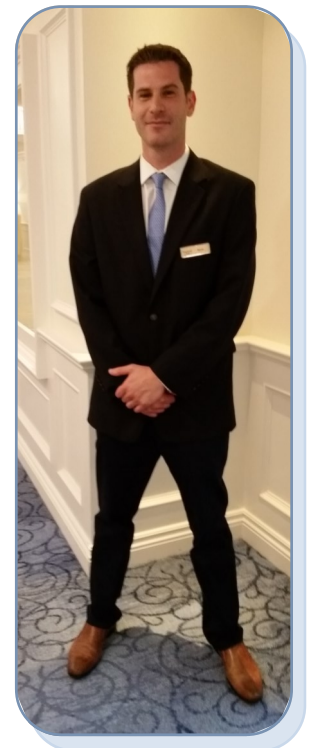
NEW STAFF MEMBERS
