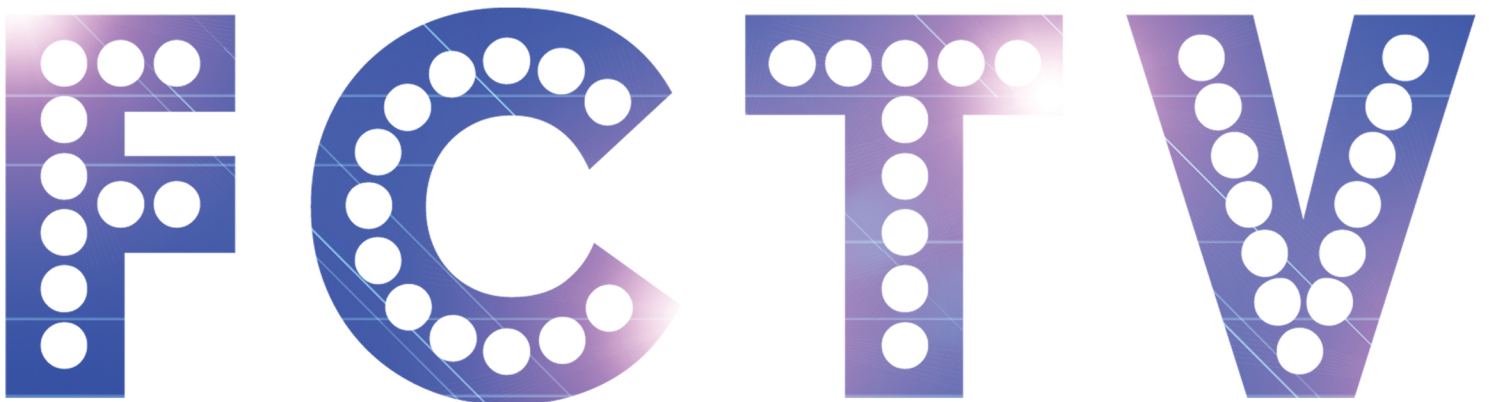

Kevin's Summer Maintenance Programs



Program 1

(should be done at least twice a year)

- Water batteries check and rotate
- Check and fill air pressure in tires
- Check wiring
- Check brakes and adjust as necessary
- Check accessories and advise on any repairs that may be needed
- Inspect for loose connections on batteries and terminals
- Address any corrosion on battery tops
- Grease all fittings
- Inspect motor for loose connections
- Report to the member any future or present problems in need of further repair



Program 2

Summer battery maintenance program is performed once a month in two parts which include:

- Check the water in the batteries, plug in cart and charge
- Unplug the charger from the wall and receptacle

Program 3

We also have a summer (June through September) refurbishing program for your golf cart which includes painting, curtains, pin striping, lettering and seat covers.

Protect Yourself From Telephone Fraud

The telephone is among the greatest inventions of the modern age. From the days of the party line to the days of wireless and Internet phones, they have connected us with loved ones, made our lives more convenient, and given us peace of mind. But telephones are also prone to fraud. Don't be a victim. Educate yourself about phone fraud, and know how to spot—and prevent—a telephone scam.

Beware of voice mail fraud

Hackers can compromise your voice mail system to make collect, third-party, or direct-dial calls at your expense. Voice mail vendors provide new customers with a default password—usually an easily-guessed combination such as 1-2-3-4. If you don't change it, hackers can guess it quickly and break into your phone system. Once a hacker knows your password, he or she can use it to make international calls at your expense.

Tip: Always change your default password immediately. Choose a complex voice mail password of at least six digits, and change it frequently.

Beware of cell phone cloning fraud

Criminals can clone your cell phone by illegally monitoring radio wave transmissions to determine your unique electronic serial number (ESN) and your cell phone number (mobile identification number [MIN]). The cloned cell phone is reprogrammed to transmit your ESN and MIN numbers. The cellular system will not be able to tell the difference and will bill you for the cloned phone's calls as well as your own.

Tip: Check your phone bill carefully, and call your carrier if you think your cell phone has been cloned.

Beware of the 809 Area Code Scam

You may receive an urgent message on your answering machine or pager requesting that you call a number immediately, usually because of a "family emergency." When you call the number, you discover that the call has nothing to do with your family. The 809 area code is actually the country code for the Dominican Republic, and later an expensive phone charge shows up on your phone bill.

Tip: Always know where you're calling before you dial. While it is usually necessary to dial 011 to reach an international location, some international locations have telephone numbers that resemble domestic long-distance calls.

• Verizon Email: A recent announcement was made by Verizon concerning their email service. Effective April 29, 2017, Verizon will no longer provide Verizon.net email service. The two options available are:

1. Migrate to AOL Mail and keep your Verizon.net email address OR
2. No longer use your current Verizon.net email address and establish an account with outlook.com or gmail.com

• Business Center: While visiting the Business Center, please remember to make sure to log off any online accounts before you leave the area. If you do not log off your accounts, but just simply close a window, the account will still be accessible by the next user. This is a friendly reminder to help keep yourself protected by logging out of your online accounts.

• Apple Update: Apple recently released a second, and unscheduled, update to patch a known vulnerability with the Wi-Fi chips used in iPhones, iPads, and iPods. This update was (10.3.1), released April 3, and follows a larger update (10.3) released a week prior. Please consider updating your devices if you have not already done so.

• Recorded Phone Calls: Some members have been receiving recorded phone calls from well-known companies, such as Microsoft, asking for return calls to fix computer problems. Please do not return these calls; they are a scam.

• Apple Store in the Gardens Mall: The Apple Store, located in the Gardens Mall, is temporarily closed for renovations. The store is expected to reopen sometime in the Fall of 2017. The closest Apple Store is located in the Wellington Green Mall. They can be reached at (561) 273-2940.

Departure Check List Suggestions

Departure Check List Suggestions

When you are leaving for the summer, please keep in mind the following items prior to your departure.

House Watch

Notify your house watch person of your departure date and time. They will check your home conditions weekly.

Electrical

Turn off all breakers, except the A/C unit, refrigerators, freezers, pool pump and your outdoor lamp post.

Air Conditioning

Set your AC to Cool, at a temperature several degrees higher than your normal temperature setting.

Newspaper Services

Discontinue your newspaper delivery or change the receiving address to your summer address.

Hurricane Shutters

Contact the Engineering Department at (561) 273-2630 for assistance in installing your hurricane shutters beginning May 1st.

Transportation

To make arrangements for your home-to-airport transportation by your vehicle, please contact the Transportation Office at (561) 331-4755.

Water Supply

Shut off water at outside connection. Also consider a second water shutoff valve inside the home. Do not leave faucets open. Shut off all valves under all sinks. Consider draining the hot water tank just before you leave. Do not arrange to have your water turned on prior to your arrival. It is important that you are home to check for leaks and faulty seals.

Secure Home

Confirm that all doors and windows are locked. Set your security alarm. Secure patio furniture and all movable items into the garage. Leave your emergency phone number and the phone number of your house watch person with the Security Department at (561) 622-7800 and the POA Office at (561) 627-1467.

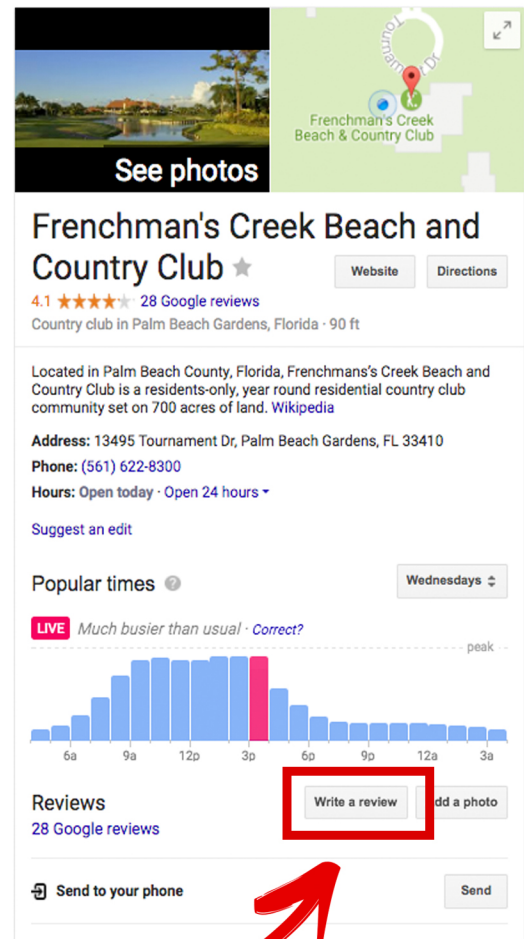
Google is often the first point of contact between a customer and a business. We plug keywords into Google to help us with anything we want to know. And if we want to find out how one business compares to another, we Google to find out about other people's experiences. Recognizing the need, Google has rolled out its own reviews feature, which allow users to write reviews directly on the business's Google or Google Map listing.



Please help the community by completing a Google Review.

Instructions to Leave Reviews

1. Enter "Frenchman's Creek Beach & Country Club" in Google, you will see this **section on** your screen. 
2. Once there, scroll down a bit until you see the heading, "Write A Review". A window will open, "Sign in with your Google account to write a review".
3. You must have a Google account to do this, so when logged in, another box will open that says "Rate and review"
4. Click inside the box below "Describe your experience"
5. Write your review, click on the five star and click on post
6. If you don't yet have a Google account, you'll need to click the button that says "Create an account now," and follow the instructions to create the account. Once created, go back to the Business Listing page and click on "Rate and review" to leave a review.



That's all there is to it. The only tripping up points are going to be if you don't yet have a Google account. But Google makes creating a new account pretty easy, so with a little assistance, you shouldn't have any trouble leaving a review.

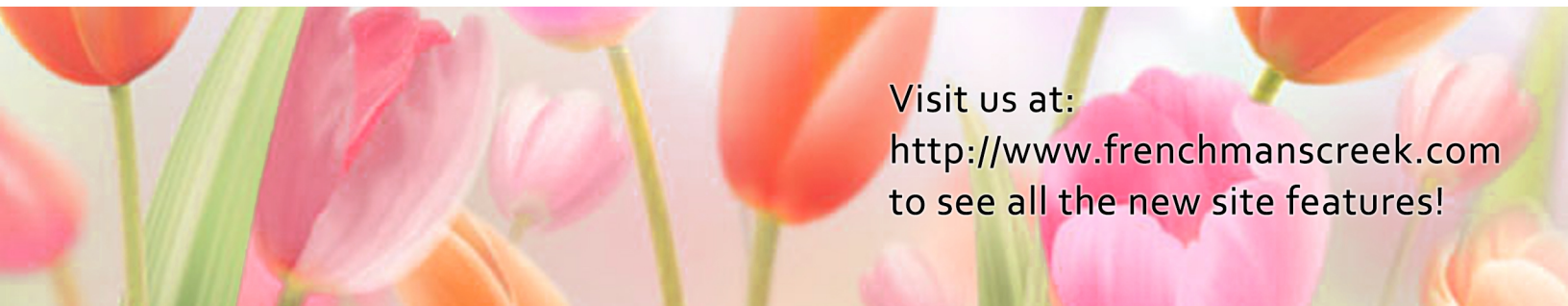
