The Classics

The Oaks Stakes was first run on Friday, 14 May 1779 and was won by the Lord Derby-owned Bridget. Well over 200 years later, the best three-year-old fillies still gather at Epsom and in 2016 the first four home were all sired by Coolmore stallions. At the Curragh they went one better when **Seventh Heaven** led home a 1-2-3-4-5. In other classic news, **Galileo**'s brilliant son **The Gurkha** ran away with the French 2,000 Guineas, **Zoffany**'s son **Knife Edge** landed the German equivalent and **Minding**, **Ballydoyle** and **Alice Springs** ran 1-2-3 in the 1,000 Guineas at Newmarket.

GALILEO's brilliant son Churchill heads the market for next year's 2,000 Guineas while his daughter **RHODODENDRON** is favourite for the 1,000 Guineas. Two of Galileo's best sons **AUSTRALIA** and **GLENEAGLES** are represented by their first yearlings in 2017 and 2018.

Middle Park Stakes winner The Last Lion is a son of **CHOISIR**, Racing Post Trophy winner Rivet is another star juvenile for **FASTNET ROCK** while Peace Envoy comes from the first crop of **POWER**.

There's a quintet of Ballydoyle-based War Fronts including the Vintage Stakes winner War Decree and the Cheveley Park 1-2 Brave Anna and Roly Poly. War Front's brilliant Dewhurst winner **WAR COMMAND** is another with his first yearlings in 2017.

So if you're looking to breed a top 2-year-old, you know where to start!

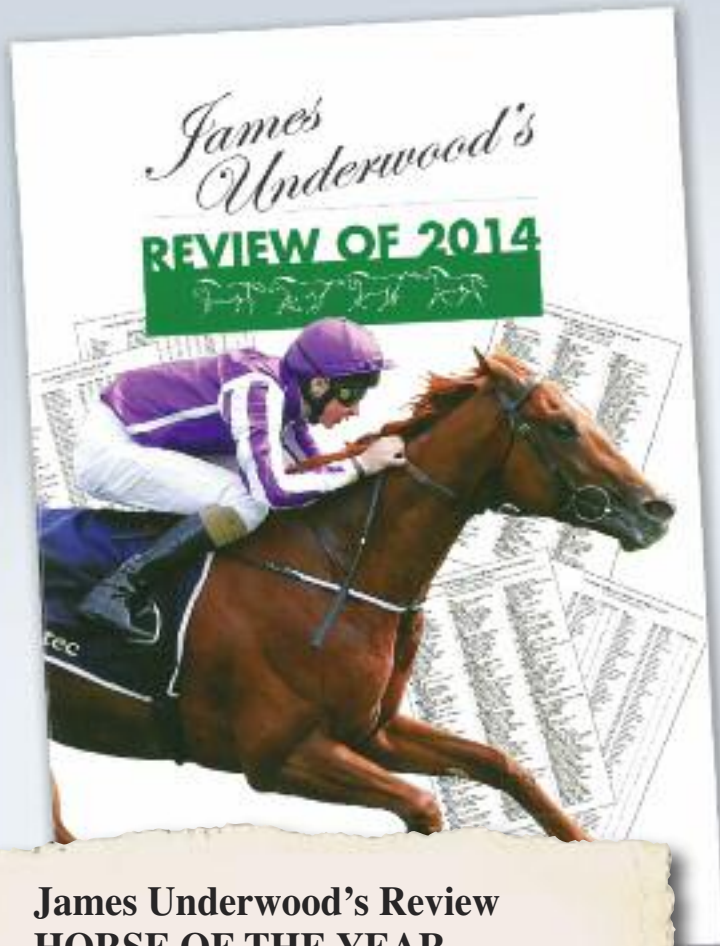

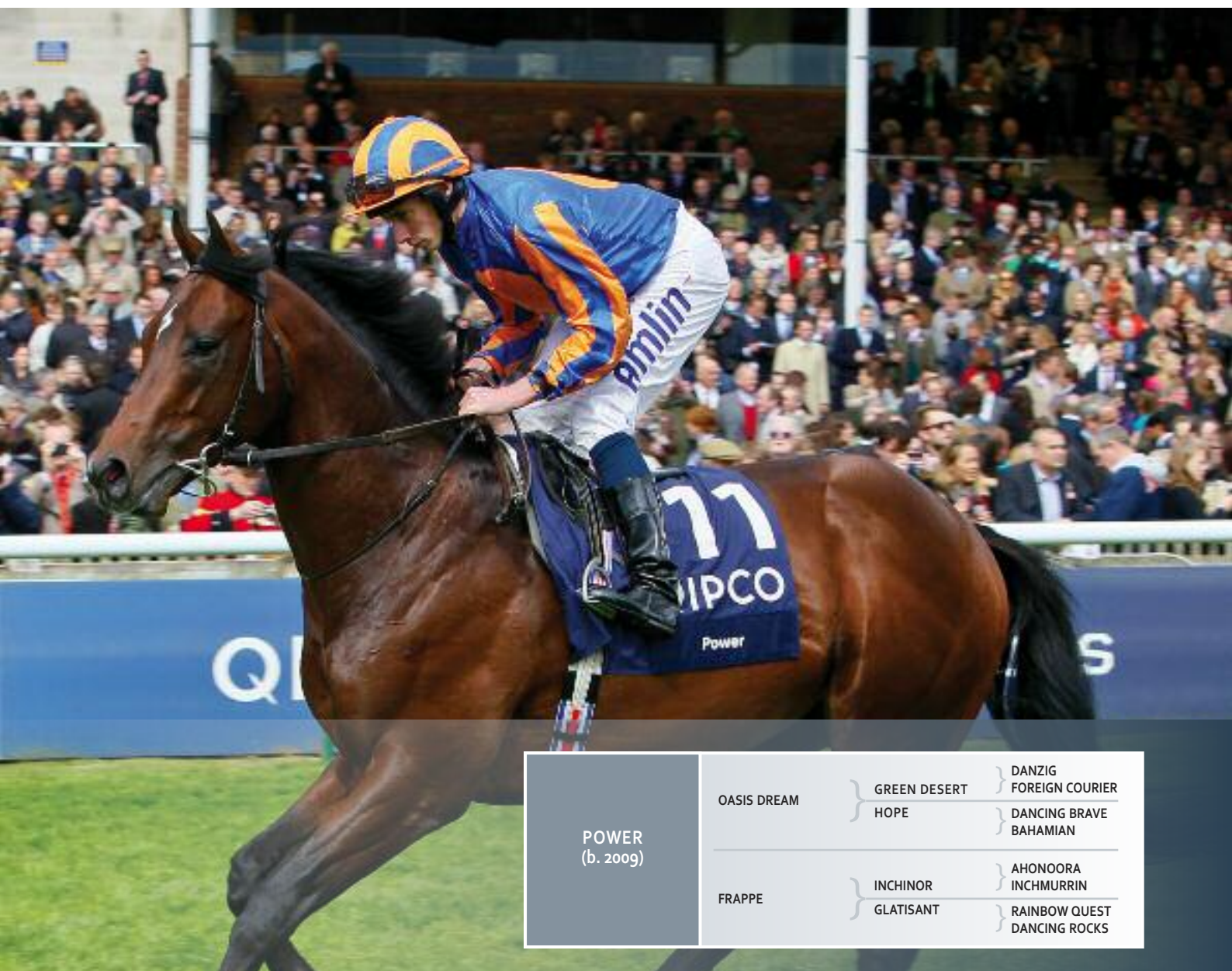

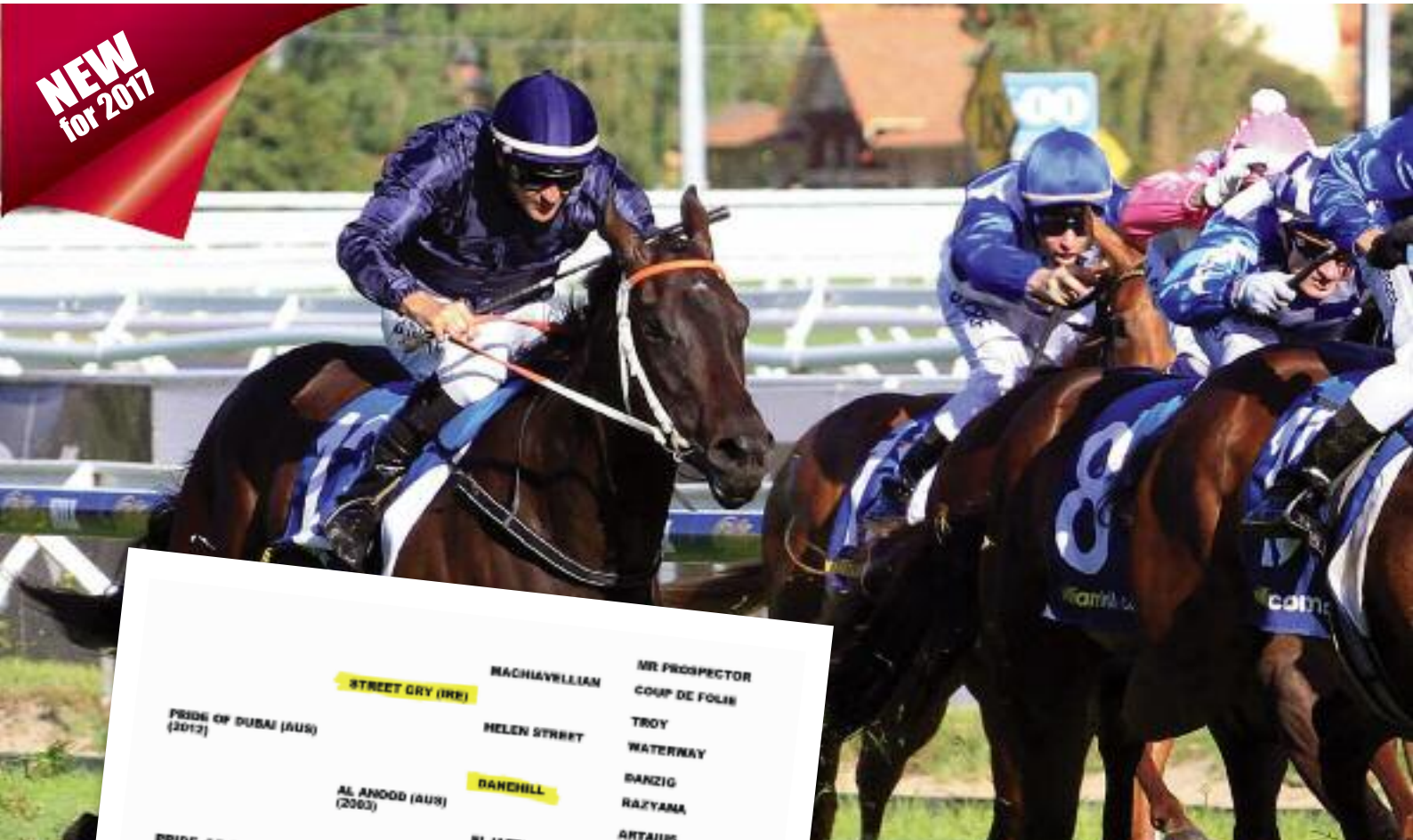

Rogers provides link between Churchill and Dewhurst star

IF WINSTON CHURCHILL was never known for his love of Ireland, his love of horses was never been in doubt. It was a trait inherited from his father Lord Randolph Churchill who owned the 1889 Oaks winner L'Abbesse de Jouarre in partnership with the 4th Earl Of Duncraven of Adare Manor, County Limerick, a property now owned by JP McManus.

A keen polo player and rider to hounds in his youth, Churchill took part in military races during his time as a cavalryman. Although he earned the disapproval of the

racing fraternity when introducing a betting tax in 1926 during a stint as chancellor of the exchequer, he rejoined the fold in triumph in the post-war years, enjoying notable success with Colonel II, the first of many good horses trained for him by Walter Nightingall.

Perhaps less well known is that Churchill also had horses trained in Ireland. His name appears on the Irish Classic roll of honour as the owner of Dark Issue, trained by

Darby Rogers to win the Irish 1,000 Guineas in 1955.

Dark Issue was actually leased to Churchill by William Barnett, a wealthy Belfast grain merchant whose best-known horse Trigs was trained in Ireland at two by Darby's father Jack Rogers. Transferred to Irishman Dick Dawson at Whitcombe at three, he won the Derby and St Leger in 1929.

Churchill continued his link with Irish bloodstock when Tim Rogers, Darby's younger son and brother of Mickey of Hard Ridden and Santa Claus fame, stood the former prime minister's horses High Hat and Vienna in Airfie Stud

near Lucas in the early 1960s.

In a curious and roundabout way, it could be said Winston Churchill has, through the personage of Tim Rogers, a connection with the horse who now carries his name.

For it was Rogers who prompted Charles Haughey as minister of finance to introduce the innovative stallion tax exemption in the budget of 1969. This was the platform that enabled Vincent O'Brien, Robert Sangster and John Magnier to stand sons of the great Northern Danter at Coolmea Stud, laying the genetic pathway through Sadler's Wells and Galileo to Saturday's Dewhurst winner.

Retiring for 2018

A brilliant son of **Scat Daddy**, the handsome **Caravaggio** went unbeaten in his four starts. Winner of his maiden in the month of April and the Marble Hill Stakes at the Curragh both over the minimum trip, he stepped up to six furlongs for the Coventry Stakes at Royal Ascot where he destroyed his rivals. Back at the Curragh for the Group 1 Phoenix Stakes it was more of the same with **Caravaggio** scoring by a facile four lengths. He's seriously fast!


