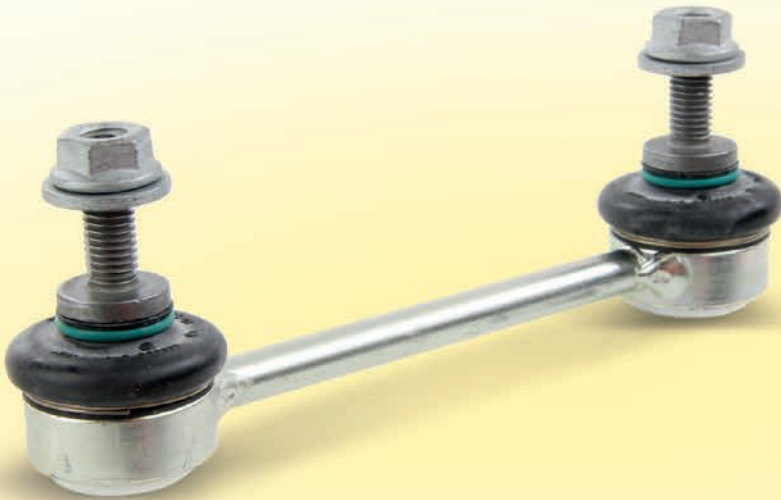




SAFETY IN STEERING & SUSPENSION
