

DOCTOR OF NURSING (DN)

About the Programme

The Catherine McAuley School of Nursing and Midwifery, University College Cork offers a taught Doctor of Nursing (DN) degree programme. The DN is a professional doctorate. The programme is completed in three years of study. The curriculum will prepare individuals to function as advanced leaders in academic and service settings or practitioners at the highest level of practice.

Entry Requirements

Applicants must:

- (a) hold active registration on a division of the professional register maintained by the Nursing Board/Statutory Body in their country of origin.
- (b) hold a Master's degree in nursing or related discipline.
- (c) if first language is not English, provide current evidence (i.e. within past 5 years) of proficiency in English of a minimum score of 6.5 with no less than a score of 6.5 in each of the components. (Candidates must comply with UCC's graduate study admission requirements).

The Pac code for the course is CKZ77 (Doctor of Nursing Practice (Full-Time)). Applicants are required to complete a full application for the programme and to submit a short research proposal, academic transcripts, professional references, professional registration details, Curriculum Vitae and identity documents.



Course duration:

The Doctor of Nursing degree is a full-time programme running for 36 months from the date of first registration for the programme. Students may apply to transfer their registration to part-time status in Year 3 of the programme, such students must complete the programme within 48 months of registration for the programme.
