

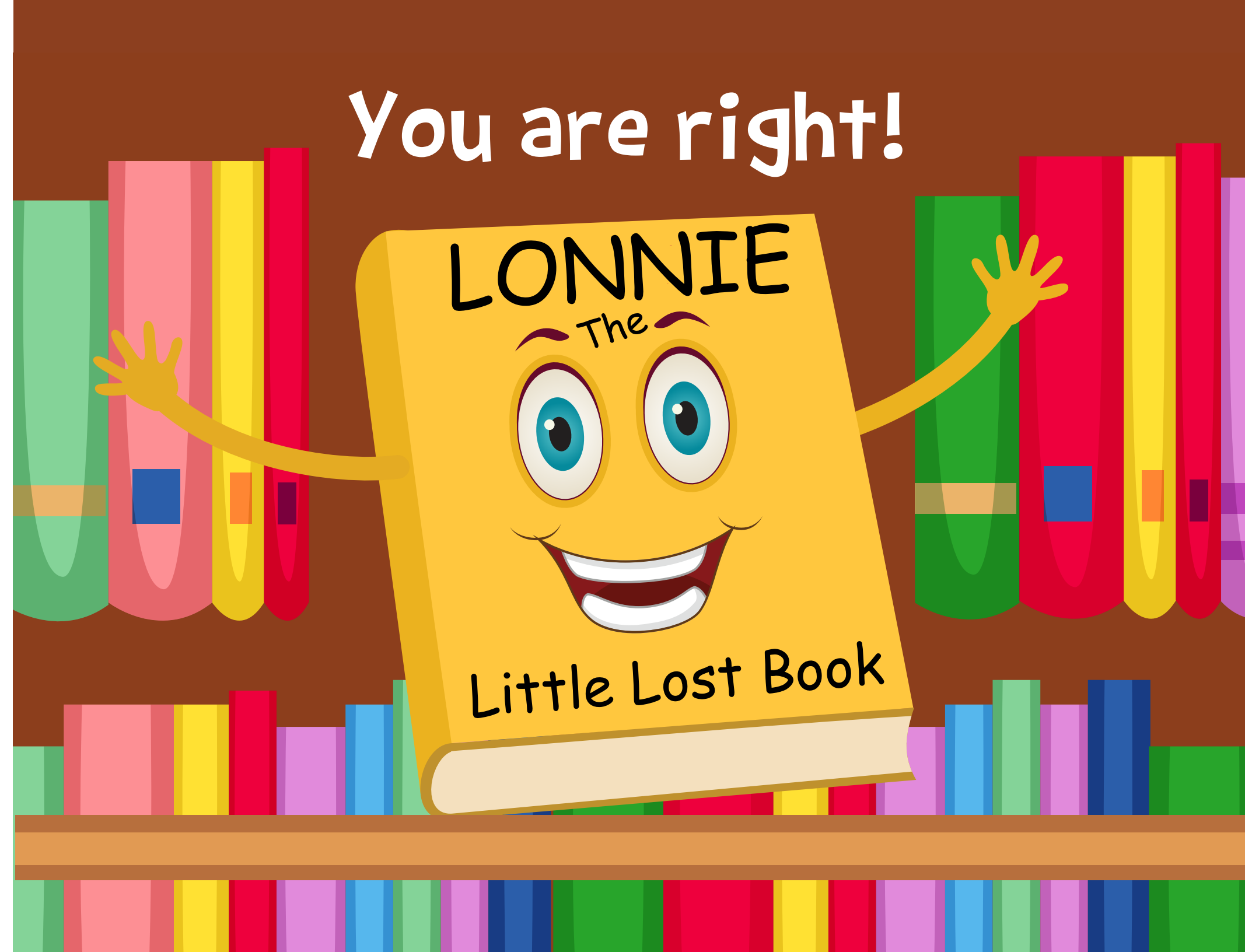
Lonnie The Little Lost Book

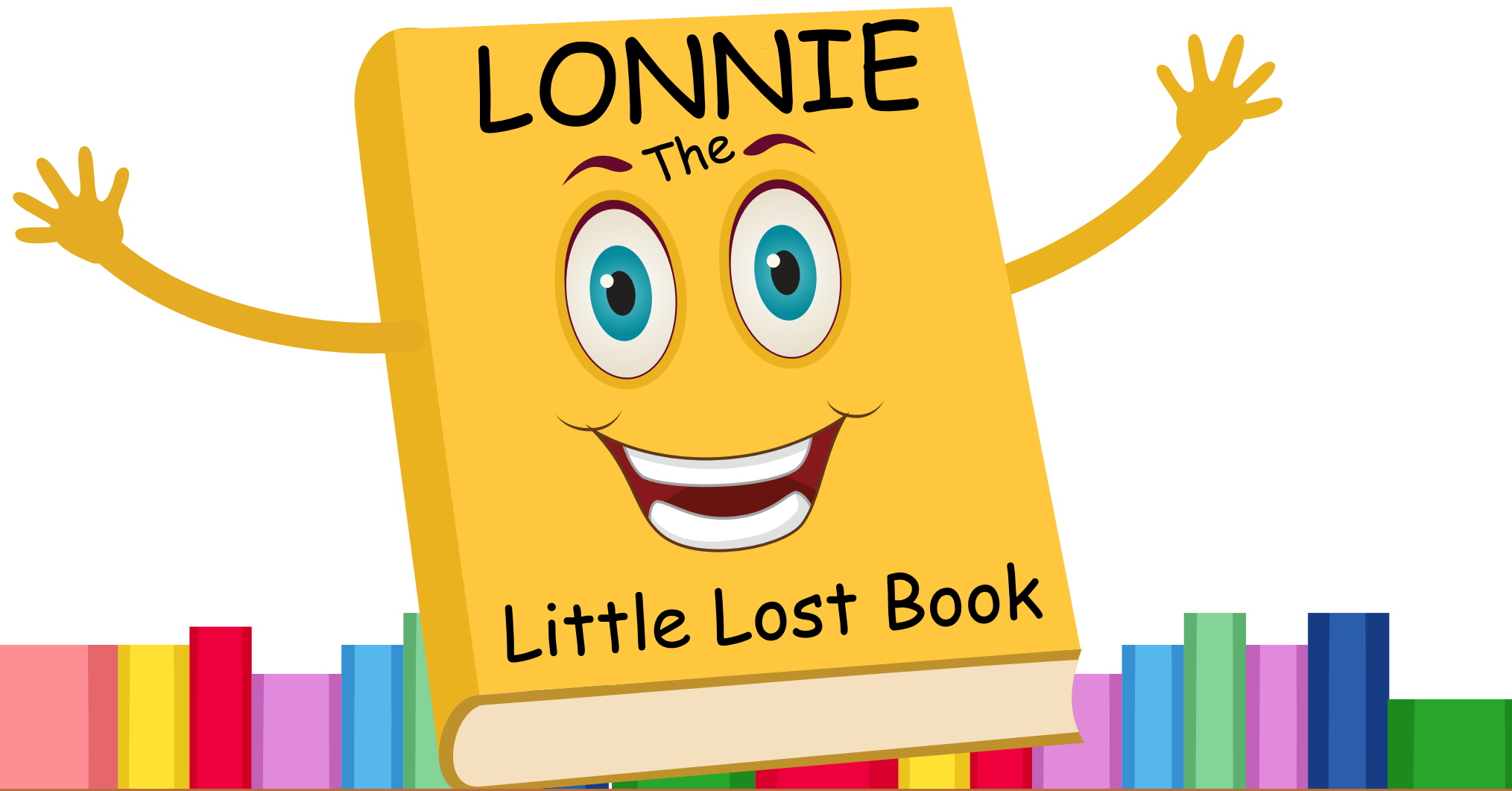


**Do you see where you should put me
