APPLE WATCH EDITION | APPLE



THE RECENT LAUNCH OF APPLE'S SMARTWATCH IS BEST

summed up as worlds colliding. We're not referring to the Apple Watch Sport (US \$399) or the Apple Watch (US \$499). We're talking about the one with an 18-karat gold case. The one that starts at US \$10,000. The one that puts high-end watchmakers directly in its crosshairs and promises to shakeup the watch industry for better or worse. The **Apple Watch Edition**.

Historically, luxury watches appeared to be one of the few markets impervious to the tech industry's disruptive innovation.

Handcrafted, bejeweled and enduring, a fine timepiece can be passed down for generations, whereas a tech accessory with a shelf life of a year or two simply cannot. But if there's one company that could change that, it's Apple.



The Apple Watch Edition is an impressive device, uniting craftsmanship and technology. Made from custom gold alloy and a sapphire crystal display, it's replete with all the apps, fitness tracking and communication possibilities that you will ever need. You can use it as a key for your car or hotel room, make payments via Apple Pay or even control your smart home from your wrist.

While initial earnings have been kept close to the vest, consumer response to the Apple Watch feels tepid compared to other recent Apple unveilings, especially when considering it's the first new product from the Silicon Valley giant since the passing of visionary founder Steve Jobs, and one can't help but wonder: did the Goliath of the tech industry step into an arena where it stacks up more like David? Not waiting until it's too late to find out, some of the watch world's biggest names are calling all hands on deck to develop a counter punch.

With Tag Heuer and Google announcing a strategic partnership at the 2015 Baselworld in Switzerland, the watch industry's premier event, comes a best of both worlds scenario, as two of the most established in their respective fields collaborate. It's fitting that Tag Heuer, the self-proclaimed Swiss Avant Garde watchmaker, is one of the early adopters of the smartwatch movement, and a key focus of their Carrera Wearable 01 is

that it will be the first Android Wear device with upgradeable technology. This means the watch itself will remain constant, unlike the Apple Watch, whose second generation is scheduled to be released before the end of 2015. At the moment, not much is known of the technology in the Carrera Wearable 01, though in a recent interview with tech-centric site Wareable.com, Tag Heuer CEO Jean-Claude Biver indicated it will closely resemble the Carrera Heuer 01 (pictured left). Current expectations have the watch being released before the end of the year, with a 40 hour battery life (more than double the Apple Watch's 18 hours) and priced around US \$1,400, considerably lower than the Edition.

Another Swiss watchmaker tossing its hat in the ring is Breitling, whose longstanding technical prowess and precision has led to an identity deeply rooted in aviation. Their first foray in the smartwatch field comes in the form of the B55 Connected, a timepiece that isn't going to be measuring your vitals or anything like that, but ultimately serves to improve upon the aviator-specific timekeeping functionalities of their watches by making it all available (and essentially more user-friendly) on a smartphone. Two LCD backlit screens provide an electronic tachometer that allows you to easily calculate the average speed needed to cover a fixed distance, a chrono-flight device records the take-off and landing times (which pilots must record) and the analog hands will automatically adjust to a new time zone, among many more aviator-oriented tools.

There are, of course, big-time brands, such as Rolex and Patek Philippe, who are standing their ground, with no immediate plans to jump in on the tech trend.

A fun hypothetical to consider though, is if the Tag Heuer-Google relationship proves a success, could it prompt Apple to seek a similar partnership? From this vantage point, the fact that Apple products do not historically appreciate in value combined with the absence of a watch brand name that boasts proven longevity (like Tag Heuer), puts them at a disadvantage. But, just imagine for a minute, the classic look of a Rolex Daytona merged with the Apple Watch interface. Now, that's something that could stack up to any competition and stand the test of time.









IF YOU'RE LOOKING TO GET OFF THE BEATEN PATH

on your next vacation, Sri Lanka just might be worth a closer look. An island nation of endless appeal located just off the Southeast coast of India, it's a destination that will charm you with its vibrant culture and jaw-dropping scenery.

The economy of Sri Lanka, formerly known as Ceylon (like the tea), is, no surprise, largely based around its longstanding relationship with the tea leaf, introduced by the British in 1824. Today, the nation is one of the world's leading producers of the ubiquitous beverage, and for travelers in search of an escape with a truly unique cultural experience, it's the Ceylon tea region that you must visit.

For all it has to offer, this enchanting land remains relatively untouched by the global tourism circuit, but perhaps most alluring is the coexistence of authenticity and simple luxury, an all too rare commodity. Amidst the rolling hillsides of this region, tea plantations are increasingly becoming intertwined with quaint boutique hotels, such as the amazing resort Ceylon Tea Trails, where the local way of life serves as the focal point.

"Tea Trails is in the heart of the magic world of Ceylon Tea, with its centuries old traditions," shares Malik J. Fernando, Managing Director of the resort, which feels more like a private estate than a hotel, with four charming Colonial era bungalows that were originally inhabited by tea pickers. A family-operated enterprise that began with a passion for Camellia Sinensis, the small plant that produces the leaves and buds used to make tea, Mr. Fernando's father, Merrill J. Fernando, founded Dilmah Tea in 1988, before they moved into the hospitality business. Today, Dilmah Tea is one of the largest global tea brands.

Bordering the UNESCO World Heritage Central Highlands, a day at Tea Trails starts with a butler serving you "Bed Tea" and drawing a bath, before a breakfast served overlooking the mesmerizing fields. From walking through a field of tea pickers to the artisanal conversion in the factory and, of course, a tasting, guests are offered a glimpse into the production of the aromatic plant. The fare, too, revolves around the local specialty, with entrees such as Moroccan mint tea crusted lamb rump steak and apple tart with Assam tea cream anglaise for dessert.

OUR PICK | Porcão Rios (porcao.com)

WHAT TO GET | You can try it all at this carnivorous, buffet-style feast, but we recommend the Picanha Tradicional – a Brazilian favorite, cut from the top sirloin and thinly sliced with just a touch of fat.

ATMOSPHERE | Sizzling slabs of meat are in constant motion, as well-dressed waiters are perpetually delivering the next course, and incredible views of Guanabara Bay serve as the backdrop.

STREET EATS

Follow your nose through the streets of Rio and you'll find a tantalizing snack available on virtually every corner. From late-night eats to beachside snacks, the street food here is widely regarded as some of the best in the world.

OUR FAVORITES The crepe-like tapiocas are a must-try for those with a sweet tooth, while a warm pão de queijo (cheesy pastry) is nothing short of a revelation.

WHERE | Post up on the gorgeous | panema Beach and let the vendors come to you or head to the Centro neighborhood for an overwhelming number of options.

THE GOURMET EXPERIENCE

The top end of the culinary culture here is second to none, and if you're looking for a fine dining experience, there's no shortage of exceptional options, from traditional to modern fusion.

ATMOSPHERE | Located at the hip Hotel Santa Teresa, Téreze has a relatively casual vibe (it's still Rio, after all) in an eco-chic setting of recycled wood furniture and massive windows overlooking Guanabara Bay.

A HANKERING FOR HEALTHY

Don't worry herbivores – there's plenty here for you, too. While it may not be as well known for its vegetarian food scene, you can grab some tasty greens to rejuvenate and detox after a long night on the town.

OUR PICK | Prana Vegetariano (pranavegetariano.com)

THE MENU | Food options change daily thanks to chef Marcos Freitas, though they're guaranteed to be packed with fresh veggies that are good and good for you. The juice bar is also an integral part, with a seemingly endless menu of juice and smoothies.

ATMOSPHERE This modern eatery is not all that big, but its reputation definitely is, so get there early if you want to beat the lunch crowd.



LOOKOUT TOWER DALKEY, IRELAND


