



<u>Financial Report</u>

Treasurer, Frank Corcoran

For the month of May revenues were \$46,749, primarily from Membership revenues of \$28,825, Bar revenues \$9,855, and Harbor and Grounds, \$7,489. Expenses of \$21,125 consisted of normal operating items. Net profit for the month was \$25,624. Year to date revenues through May were \$175,341 and expenses \$72,568, resulting in year to date profit of \$102,774.
