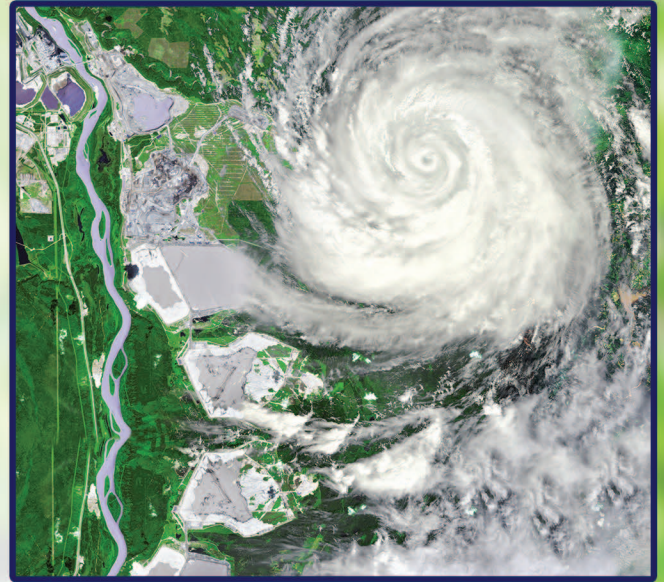
HOUSE WATCH

Please remember, after your work is completed in the **Business Center**, please make sure to log off any online accounts before you leave the area. If you do not log off your accounts, but just simply close a window, the account will still be accessible by the next user. This is a friendly reminder to help keep yourself protected by logging out of your online accounts.

Apple Store in the Gardens Mall

The Apple store, located in the **Gardens Mall**, is closed for renovations. The store is expected to reopen sometime in the Fall of 2017. The closest Apple Store is located in Wellington in the **Wellington Green Mall**.

Plan Ahead

Hurricane season has begun and the rain is here; plan for power spikes. In order to keep your data safe, or in case of a hardware failure, it is good practice to have it on removable storage. You can use a thumb drive, an external hard drive, or anything else that stores data off of the computer. In addition, best practice is to isolate your computer from the wall outlet by first plugging into a surge protector. Plugging your computer into a surge protector first and then into a wall outlet second will help prevent your computer from suffering a catastrophic hardware failure. South Florida is the lightning capital of the world so keeping your computer powered through one of these devices will help protect you from permanently losing your data.

Spam Settings

If you are not receiving Frenchman's Creek communications it could be because your email provider has listed these emails as either spam or, in the case of Google email, promotions. Once email has been classified as either spam or promotions, these emails will no longer show in your inbox. To fix this issue, right click on the email and select "Not Junk." You can also select the checkbox next to the email, if using Google email, and then click "Not Junk."

Clean Up!

Summer is a great time to purge data. Delete emails, files, empty Internet browser cache, and old folders of digital garbage. Doing this will free hard drive space and may help speed up your computer.

Safety Tips For 4th of July Holiday

- Obey all local laws regarding the use of fireworks.
- Know your fireworks; read the cautionary labels and performance descriptions before igniting.
- A responsible adult **SHOULD SUPERVISE** all firework activities. Never give fireworks to children.
- Alcohol and fireworks do not mix. Save your alcohol for after the show.
- Wear safety glasses when shooting fireworks.
- Light one firework at a time and then quickly move away.
- Use fireworks **OUTDOORS** in a clear area; away from buildings and vehicles.
- Never relight a “dud” firework. Wait 20 minutes and then soak it in a bucket of water.
- Always have a bucket of water and charged water hose nearby.
- Never carry fireworks in your **POCKET** or shoot them into **METAL** or **GLASS** containers.
- Do not experiment with homemade fireworks.

- Dispose of spent fireworks by wetting them down and place in a metal trash can away from any building or combustible materials until the next day.
- FAA regulations **PROHIBIT** the possession and transportation of fireworks in your checked baggage or carry-on luggage.
- Report illegal explosives, like M-80s and quarter sticks, to the fire or police department.

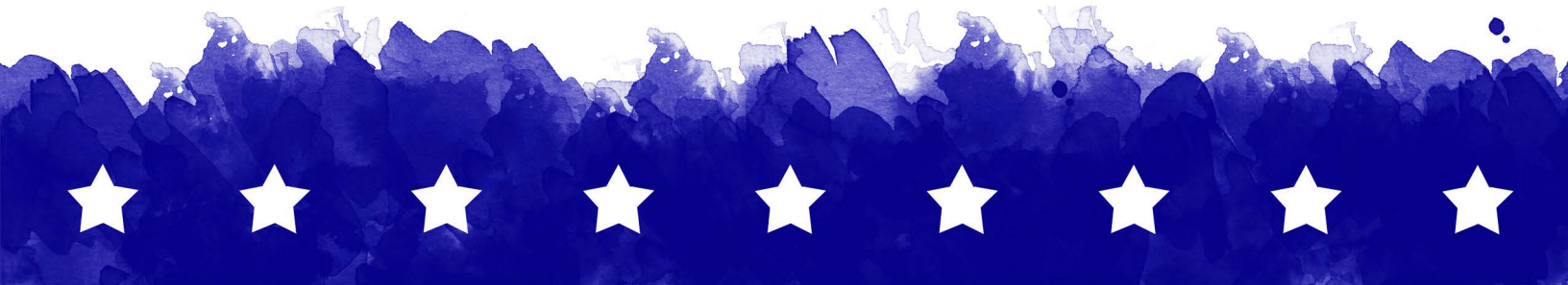
And let's not forget the safety of our pets!

- ✓ Don't bring your pets to a fireworks display, even a small one.
- ✓ If fireworks are being used near your home, put your pet in a safe, interior room to avoid exposure to the sound.
- ✓ Make sure your pet has an identification tag, in case it runs off during a fireworks display.
- ✓ Never shoot fireworks of any kind (consumer fireworks, sparklers, fountains, etc.) near pets.
