1234YF - News from Europe



espite strong German opposition to the new car air conditioning refrigerant R1234yf, around 500,000 cars have already been registered in the country with the new gas.

Figures showing that 458,532 new vehicles were registered and using the new refrigerant between January 2013 and June 2015, were revealed by the German government in answer to questions from the Left Party (Die Linke).

In response, the German government repeated previous statements that, backed by the results of numerous independent and industry studies, it sees no significant risks in using the new refrigerant.

Since January 2013, all new types of vehicle registered and marketed in the EU have

to contain an air conditioning refrigerant with a GWP under 150. This effectively bans the use of industry standard refrigerant R134a, leaving the new "mildly flammable" HFO R1234yf as the only currently available choice.

Despite this, Mercedes manufacturer Daimler has refused to adopt the new refrigerant due to safety fears and continues to use R134a. in direct contravention of the MAC directive. This has left the German government, on one side, facing European Commission infringement proceedings and, on the other, severe criticism from the German media backing the stance of Daimler. But now in a U-turn Mercedes and VW have started working on 1234YF

While Mercedes and VW are conspicuously absent from the list released by the government, a total of 44 manufacturers and 85 different car models, including those of fellow German car manufacturers BMW and Vauxhall, are listed. Refrigerant manufacturer DuPont has previously predicted that, globally, more than 7 million cars using the new refrigerant are expected to be on the road by the end of this year.

Both Mercedes and VW have pinned their future on CO² and have indicated that vehicles could be available as early as next year.

Catalytic Converters & Coil Packs

What you need to know!

he Catalytic Converter is part of the emission control system situated in the exhaust stream. The Catalytic Converter converts toxic gases in the exhaust system into less harmful gases.

INSTALLATION AND CARE

- Service the vehicle on a regular basis
- Investigate any warning lights promptly; delaying fixing a problem may cause damage to the Catalytic Converter
- Only use Catalyst friendly fuel additives
- Don't remove and run a vehicle without the Catalytic Converter
- Avoid repeated short journeys & sudden heat changes (e.g. driving through deep puddles)
- Avoid harsh or excessive shocks (e.g. navigating speed bumps)

• Don't use exhaust paste upstream of the Catalytic Converter

Reasons for Catalytic convertor failure could range from internal or external factors :


INTERNAL FAILURE

- Engine over-fuelling (often caused by faulty/failed Lambda/airflow sensors)
- Poor quality fuels

- Excessive engine oil consumption
- Sintering/ageing normally only occurs with high mileage
- Repeated cold running (short journeys, Catalytic Converter not reaching operating temperature)

EXTERNAL FAILURE

Well-constructed Catalytic Converters are not prone to fail unless they have suffered





impact damage (speed-bumps, rocks, kerbs, accident damage) that may deform the catalyst and/or break the delicate honeycomb structure of the catalyst material inside.

WHAT TO LOOK FOR?

- Marks/indentations on the shell exterior
- 'Blueing' on the shell exterior (indicates higher than acceptable internal temperatures)
- Sooty deposits on the inlet of the converter
- Physical damage to the internal ceramic monolith
- Air leaks in induction/exhaust system

A faulty coil pack could damage your catalytic converter. Always make sure that you check catalytic converter condition after you replace a coil pack


It is more cost effective to explain to your customer that the failed coil pack has damaged their cat, which could result in an MOT failure, thus giving your customer time to come to terms with the inevitable.

4 GAS READINGS WHEN THE CATALYTIC CONVERTER IS OK:

- CO <0.3%
- CO² 13.5%>
- HC <15% PPM
- O² < 0.2%


Schrader Programmable

These were released by Schrader this week, the best type of customer that you should target first should be your local tyre fitters to get the first sales on the board.


